

# Skyline cuts Harts' record

Skyline College took first in Saturday's Coast Conference track and field championships breaking Hartnell's nine-year reign on the meet crown.

Skyline of San Bruno, which has won every dual meet it has competed in for two seasons, took 11 first places in Saturday's meet at Hartnell's all-weather track. Hartnell, which finished second, had just three firsts but received key points with its runnerup finishes.

Hampered by pulled muscles, Hartnell's Ron Hall and James Tucker added valuable points for their team. Hall turned in personal best performances in his first place long jump (22-6) and 440-yard dash (50.0).

Justin Thornberg's 184-3½ javelin throw was good for a first. Hartnell's 440-yard relay team took first in 42.5. The team is composed of Tucker, Williams, Burt Codera and Ron Hall.

Skyline sprinter Raphael Smith tied a meet record with his 14.4 time in the 120-yard high hurdles. Delton Gerard was second, breaking a Hartnell school record with his 14.7 time.

Life time best marks recorded by Hartnell spikers were: Mike Gourley (10:40.2) - Glen Pruitt (10:54.7) steeple chase; Ron Hall long jump (22-6), 440 (50.0); Gerard 120 hurdles (14.7), Long jump (21-½), Intermediate hurdles (55.4); Gaylen Woods, intermediate hurdles 56.6; Bruce Nearn discus (145-0).

Seven Panthers and two relay teams will go to the Porterville hosted State Small JC meet Saturday. Hartnell's 440, and mile relay teams qualified. Individual Panthers qualifying were: Ken Gardner shot put (44-8½); Ron Hall, long jump (22-6), 440 (50.0); Gerard high hurdles, 440, Intermediate hurdles; Thornberg, javelin; Dwayne Hall, 220; Bruce Johnson, high jump (6-2), Nearn discus.

Monterey's Milt Carter won the High Point Trophy scoring 34 points and two first place finishes.

Monterey finished third with Milt Carter running a 9.8 first place 100 and Mark Jensen a first place 4:21.4 mile. Carter also captured the 220 honors with his 21.9 effort.

Hartnell was prevented from winning its 10th consecutive meet crown by Skyline. Hartnell coach and athletic director Ed Adams coached the Panthers to their first meet championship in 1966. Gary Shaw continued the tradition taking over for Adams in 1969.
