## Trojans Champs

The awesome sprint strength of Skyline College turned back late-blossoming Monterey Peninsula's field and distance onslaught as the Trojans repeated as Coast Conference track and field cham-

pions Saturday.

Host Skyline tallied 199 points to 158 for the Lobos, while Hartnell slipped to third with 108-lowest finish for the Panthers in a decade. Menlo was fifth with 18. Even though Skyine has never lost a dual meet in five seasons in the Coast Conference, it wasn't until 1976 that the Trojans could end Hartnell's nine-year hold on the league title.

Skyline will next seek the California Small Conference Invitational crown Friday in Porterville before joining College of San Mateo Saturday for action at Fresno's West Coast Relays. Top two finishers in each event Saturday qualified for the Porterville affair and the Trojans will have nine athletes in 16 spots on Friday.

Skyline speedsters Tony Hicks and Alvin Diles came back from minor leg injuries to win two events apiece Saturday and Hicks also chased teammate Raphael Smith to the wire in the 110 high hurdles, both clocking 14.5.

But the to mark of the meet was a 9:18.4 steeplechase triumph by Trojan Jim Martinelli, edging the number two time in the state posted Friday night by CSM's Dave Hull (9:18.8) in the Golden Gate Conference finals. Porterville's Joaquin Leano from Mexico (9:02.2) is the state and national leader. Skyline's Bill Amable moved up to number six in Northern California with his third place 9:28.6

A 1-2-3 sweep of the 200 by Diles (22.2), Robert Clay and Mitchell Lockett over MPC's Percy Davis was the capper. after Monterey lost its other entrant. Ben Garner, on a false start. Ellis Tatum took fifth for Skyline in 23.2, almost catching Davis (23.3). MPC also dropped the baton in both relays.

Diles and Clay also finished in the same order in a Skyline track record 48.5 400. NorCal intermediate hurdle leader Hicks (51.7) and Smith (52.6) leafed to a near deadheat in 55.0 and 55.2, respectively, holding hands across the finish.
