

Scott Named Top Athlete in Track

Tom Scott of College of the Desert was named the most outstanding athlete of the day in the Desert Conference track meet Saturday at Imperial Valley Junior College.

The hosting Arabs—27 strong—won the meet with 146 points while the 'Runners were second with 98. COD had an 11-man team. Their sprinter George Shibata qualified in the 100 and 220 prelims but re-injured his left hamstring muscle in the 100 and was unable to finish.

Coach Tom O'Connor will take five of his squad to the Junior College State track prelims, May 15 at Cerritos College.

Besides Scott, who won the

100 and 220 and was anchor man on the winning COD 440 relay, there will be Rocky Harshman, Carl Brenagh, Shed Miller and Tommy Edwards in the prelims.

Harshman won the shotput and high jump events Saturday and took third in the discus.

Brenagh, Miller and Edwards are members of the relay team. Brenagh took third in the long and triple jumps.

Miller won the 440, took fifth in the 100, and second in the 220, while Edwards was fourth in the triple.

Mike Neeley of COD took fifth in the javelin and shotput. He was fourth in the discus and

Harshman third.

John Taboada and Dave Stowe of COD were third and fourth in the two-mile and fifth and sixth in the mile. Taboada was fourth in the pole vault and 880.

Tom Orenchek was fifth in the triple.

The winning Arabs qualified five (Evans, Sanchez, D. Walker, Hernandez and Montejana) for the state prelims while MiraCosta, Barstow and Palo Verde qualified one each and Victor Valley failed to qualify anyone.

May 18 is the date of the Southern California finals at Cerritos while the state finals will be held, June 24 at Modesto.
