Bob Roggy - Southern Ill. senior, 6-3, 228 lb, javelin winner at 259-9:

"My run-up was much shorter than usual, seven steps. Usually I take 14. It was muddy and a mess. But it's a lot like the place where I train at Carbondale, always flooded. So I just decided to work on technique today after I got a 259 throw on my first try."

John McDonnell - coach of Arkansas which won the 4 x 1600 Meter Relay:

"We were exactly where we had hoped we would be. We were shooting for 16:20. I guess we were just half-a-second off. Not bad!"

Mike Clark - Arkansas senior who anchored with 3:57.3, which translates to 3:58.9, the 10th best mile on the Relays circuit:

"Distance running is a tradition at Arkansas. We are lucky this year since we have two outstanding freshmen in Mark Anderson and Tom Camien. They will take our places when we, Steve Baker and I leave."

Bill Mayer - winner of Masters 800, an owner of a mortgage company in Houston:

"I guess running for masters has been an outshoot from the jogging craze which is sweeping the country. Last year I got the sixth-best time in a Seniors Olympics in Edinborough, Scotland. I train with the Rice team in Houston, and they're a big help."

Niall O'Shaughnessy - ex-Arkansas winner of mile in 4:01.78, a fifth-year civil engineering graduate:

"This is my first outdoor meet. I've been doing mainly overdistance work because my season will stretch into September -- the European Championships. We really needed a faster pace, around 1:59 for the half, to have a chance at a sub-four."

Steve Settle, prep shot put winner at 63-1 1/4, 5-11 by 167 lb, his best this year is 65-4, senior at Nevada:

"I was looking for about 65 or 66 feet today, I guess I was just off track. My form wasn't too good. I had a slow trail leg. I hope to head out to the west coast and maybe go to school somewhere out there where I can train year-round."

Craig Nordlie - senior at Nevada who won 110-Meter High Hurdles in new record of 14.49:

"The wind didn't bother me, I was too busy worrying about the other guys. My best has been at State last year -- 14.3. I wasn't running after a time, I was running to win." Nordlie has a scholarship for football at UNI and may do track, too.

Mike Boit, Eastern New Mexico and Stanford(masters) grad.:

"What would you think of someone who ran 1:46.1 in their first meet of the season? I've been training only three weeks because I had a bad achilles."

Carl Williams, junior at UC-Irvine; winner of long jump at 25-10:
