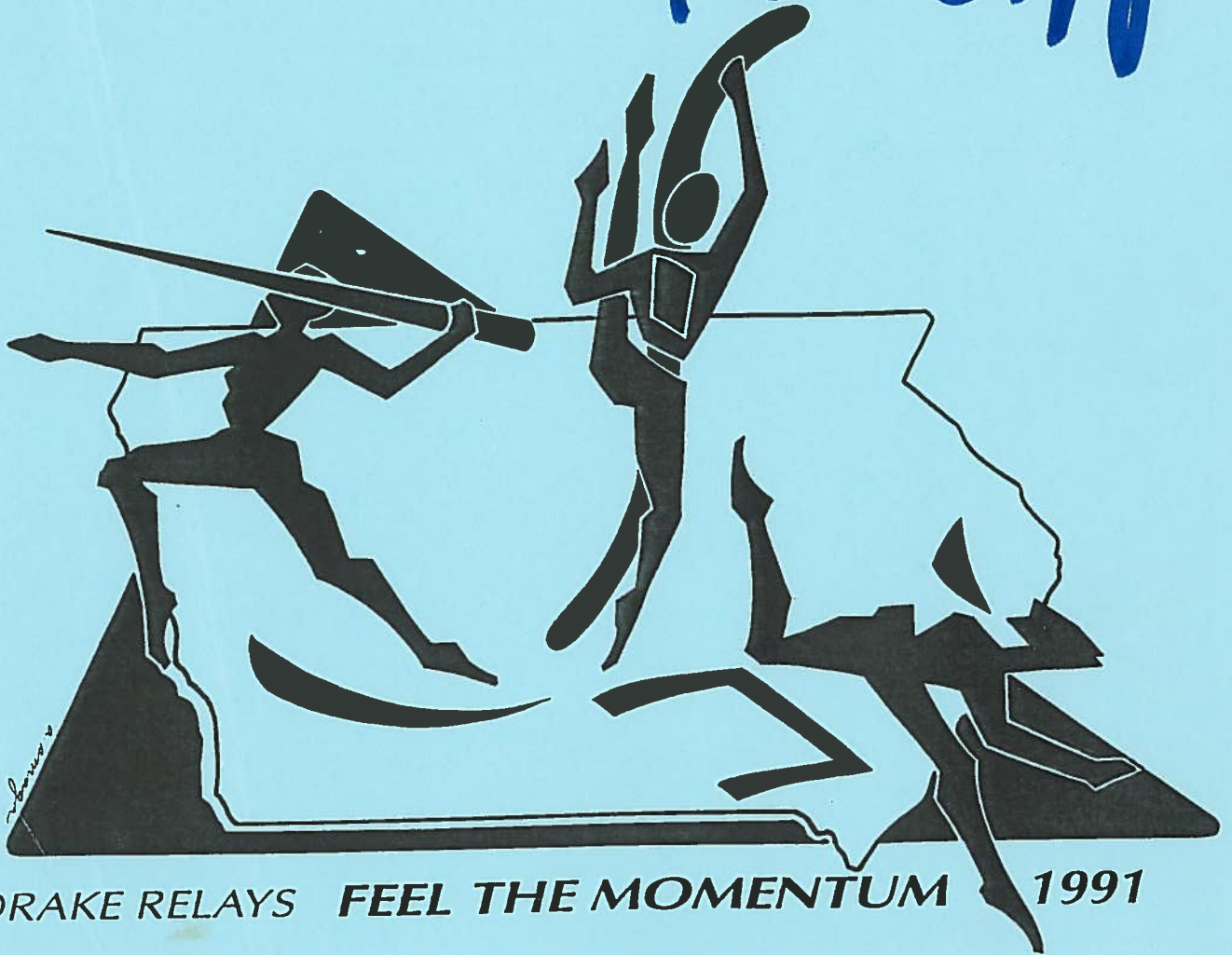

Todd Johnston, Waterloo West: Winner, High School High Jump at 6-7

It would have been nice to have a clean win at 6-9 but given the conditions I'm happy with this jump. I'm glad the rain let up so we could get through the first round. My plant is my toe so the wet surface didn't bother me as much as the guys who plant with their heel. I think I'm going to go out and buy a pair of high jump shoes now. They have heel spikes. I've been wearing the same track spikes I bought off a kid in 8th grade. They're working though.

Lynne Frey, Nebraska: Winner, Women's Javelin, 49.36 (161-11)

It was a little hard to get warmed up and get moving. Everything was wet, including my shoes. The wind was coming head on which is great but I wasn't able to take full advantage of it. I was pleased to get off a throw in the same range as my PR throw of 162-1 last week at Kansas. I finished third in the Drake Relays Heptathlon last year and didn't compete in the open javelin here. This year I'm concentrating on the javelin and that has really helped me improve.

Cynthia Moore, Arkansas: Winner, Women's Triple Jump, 12.24 (40-2)

I felt okay even though it was a little cool out here this morning. I've had to compete in the rain at just about every meet this spring and today was no different. I've still got lots of things to work on but I'll be patient and they will come soon.

John Nuttall, Iowa State: Anchor on Winning Men's U-C 4x1600-Meter Relay in 16:25.37

We knew we had a strong team and that we were favored to win. When we woke up this morning it was raining and cold so we knew the record might not be possible. It's a tough record. We decided to just concentrate on the win. For me, it was nice to take it easy. I just enjoyed the race and the victory.

The streak (now 5 in a row) began the first year I was at Iowa State. This is my last time but we've got three guys coming back and the Coach Bergan has some good prospects so I hopefully we can keep it going and make it 10 in a row.

Donnie Stecher, Iowa City: Winner, High School Boys 100-Meter Dash in 11.20

This is my biggest win. This is a starting block. My dream is to go on and win state. I usually get out to a fast start so this race was unusual for me. But in the last fifteen to twenty meters I kicked it in. This is incredible. I have gotten stronger (from last year) and that is the big difference.

Mary Beth Labosky, University of Kansas: Winner, University Women's High Jump,

I have been working at this height all season and have been coming close. Now there will not be any barriers for me. I was able to jump well today due to concentrating on my technique. I knew if I kept that focus then everything would eventually come together and it did today. I focused on doing things right.

This is my first Drake Relays and I love it here. I heard about the people in the stands. This is fantastic. My first Relays... and I do a personal best. From here I hope to qualify for the nationals.

Brett Carney, Iowa State: Anchor of Winning Mens University 4x800 Meter Relay in 7:20.31

James (Hall) flat out ran the race of his life. He sparked us when he worked his way from sixth to first place.

We know what the relays mean... in front of a large home crowd and outstanding competition. We knew we could run better than we did at the indoor nationals. We knew all along that we could do it but it wasn't easy. When he (Cecil Shy) passed me, it brought back a memory from high school when we went to the wire. But at that point, the tremendous support of the crowd triggered something inside me and I took off. This race makes us more intent on working hard and moving forward.

Bridget Smyth, Arizona: Anchor on Winning Women's Distance Medley Relay in 11.11.18 - Drake Relays Record.

We haven't run together before as a relay team but we were all within the top one or two in our respective specialties so we knew we could do well if we just stayed close. We didn't know what all these Midwestern and Eastern teams could do. In the southwest the longer relay races aren't as common.

We have to give a lot of credit to our new coach, Sue Parks. She just came in from Michigan State in January and has really helped us along.

The crowd here is great. Out at our meets we usually get about three people and a dog. I'm really pleased to come to a meet like this and get such good support.

Guy Willey, Ames: Anchor on Winning High School Boys 4x800-Meter Relay in 8:01.81

This was our fastest time by about 13 seconds. I give all the credit to my teammates who gave me a 20 meter lead on the handoff. I just ran the first lap easy and then at about 500 meters I snuck a peek and didn't see anybody behind me so I ran steady through to the end. Nobody expected us to be in contention this year. We lost three guys from our team that finished second last year.

Tashika Lewis, Des Moines North: Winner High School Girls Invit. 100-Meter Dash in 12.89

Before the race I had a lot of people telling me to warm up a lot and get out of the blocks fast. I still have a lot of work to do on the start. I didn't really start running until the 8th grade. I moved up to Des Moines from Louisiana and didn't really know of any track clubs.

Kim Carson (of Des Moines Roosevelt) and I have been friends for a while now and, with all due respect to her I knew that to win I would have to stay even with her all the way. It was close. I'm still nervous now.

Shaun Benefield, Mason City: Winner High School Boys 400-Meter Low Hurdles in 53.27

I ran a faster race than I thought. There was a lot of pressure in this race and a lot of it I put on myself. (Doug) Dodd and I come from the same area and the same newspaper reports about us. I knew he wanted this real bad and I did to. I guess I am putting too much thought into track instead of just running. Yes, this is a big race for me. It is my top race. I think that Drake is more important than winning state. The competition comes across the classes. It is a big win for me.

Kevin Walker, Baylor: Winner of University-College 400-Meter Intermediate Hurdles in :51.26.

I feel good about winning this race. Coming off the Texas Relays win, It was an important race for me. I really looked forward to running here but just before the race my legs felt like they died. I was a little nervous but I don't think it was the nerves. It could have been the airplane ride or something else but as I continued in the race everything worked out. Both the Texas and Drake wins are big races. From here I feel great about the rest of the season. I feel so much stronger... and I am in control of my race."

Danny Harris, Nike International: Winner of 400-Meter Intermediate Hurdles, Men's Special Invitational in :48.52, the fastest time in the world in 1991.

Running is always easy when you come back to the Drake Relays. Catching (Patrick) McGhee early really helped my confidence. The track was very fast and it felt good. The crowd here is what really make you go though.

My time was okay but it was not great. I will have to run a heck of a lot faster when I compete later this year. My goal is to win the World Championships in Tokyo in August and this is a good start. I think maturity has helped me. I was a little nervous being this was my first hurdle race of the year. I am pleased with it.

I'm going to train for the next month in preparation for a meet in Seville, Spain on May 30th. I would evaluate this race as a good start for the season.

Grady Labbe, Southwestern Louisiana: Lead-off on Winning Univ.4x200-Meter Relay in 1:22.08

We spent the last week working on our exchanges and they went very well today. We've really been up and down all year. But we cut a full second off our previous best today. It's a PR for us on this. This is our first team victory at the Drake Relays. We can't wait to get the watches. We wanted to show people at the Drake Relays who we are, where we're from and what we can do. I hope this victory put us on the map.

Nikole Hennigan, W.D.M. Dowling: Winner, High School Girls 800-Meter Run in 2:15.40

My plan was to run a 2:15 today. I was very nervous before the race because there was pressure coming from the fact I won the state meet last year and people were expecting me to do well today. I finished fourth as a freshman, third as a sophomore. This is my junior year and I just decided I didn't want to progress one place each year -- it was time to win now.

I didn't think anyone was behind me but you hear these people yelling for others so you're not sure who's back there. When I realized no one was back there I just pretended so I would run harder.

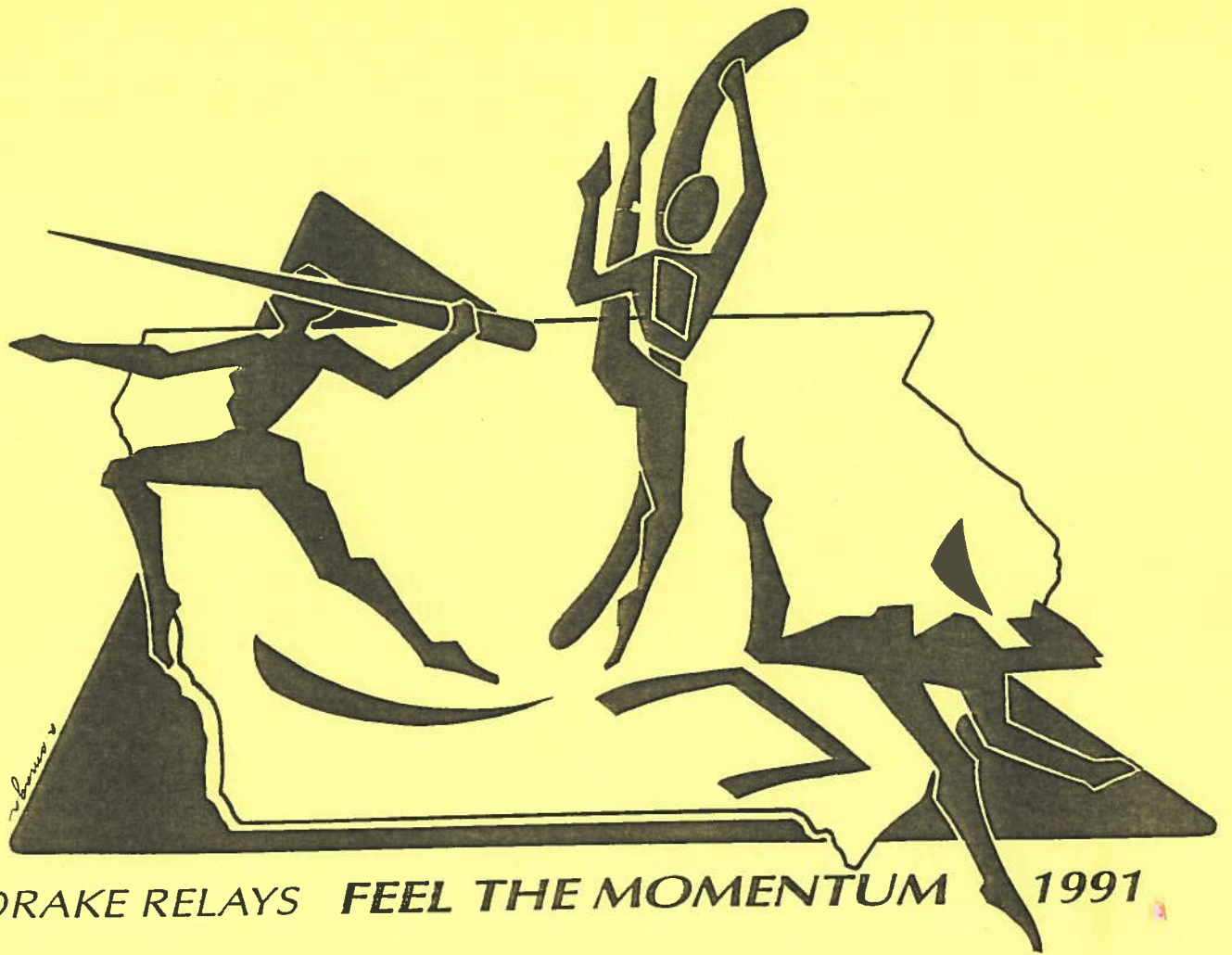

This was sweet revenge. Three years ago, I was the only member of the current team that was beat by Cal Poly. This was sweet but Cal Poly wasn't here last year when we won the race. This is our biggest meet and our goal is always to win at Drake. We are very team oriented and so we work together well.

Joel Sward, Drake: Second in Men's Shot Put.

I am disappointed for not winning. I am not very happy with the distance that I threw today but you have to take your hat off to him. He came through to beat me.

One of my goals is to be a Drake Relays champion. I have been working hard. My technique is improving. You have to work to be one of the top guys in your field. Once you get to that level and cope with that, the sky's the limit.

Gwen Torrence, Nike South: Winner of Women's 400-Meter Dash, Special Invitational in :51.61.

The crowd here is great. They made me feel like Flo Jo. I think this is the best crowd in the United States. They make you feel so welcome. I will come here forever if they let me.

I thought the wind was going to blow me out but I have prepared for this.

It was good that she (Natasha Kaiser) was in front of me because I could see here all the way. When she didn't close in on me in the last 250 meters, I knew that I had her because nobody will run me down in the last 100 meters because I am so strong.

Rounding the corners are not my bag. This is my last 400 meter race. I think I will stick to 100 and 200 meters because I feel much more comfortable at those distances.

David Knight, Iowa State: 2nd Leg of winning University Distance Medley Relay.

With the guys we have, we knew that we could run together and be successful and today we showed that. We have done our work. I think as we continue to do this and run this fast, we will improve and come to expect it in future races.

Karen Glerum, Iowa State: Winner of Women's Invitational 1,500 Meter Run

This was a hard race in the beginning but as the race continued things came together. I like running from behind.

After I was redshirted I kept putting off my injury and I think today was the first time I have run and not felt that. Today felt like the old feeling was back.

Barbara Smith, Prairie View: Anchor on Winning Women's Sprint Medley Relay in 3:54.64

We really wanted to win this race today for Jackie (PV Coach Barbara Jacket) because it's her last year, as well as for Easter Gabriel who's being named to the Drake Hall of Fame. I didn't really have a strategy. I just went out as hard as possible -- whatever it took to win.

Jim Gibson, Yale: Winner U-C 3,000-Meter Steeplechase in 8:47.87

I saw Duval, the Iowa State runner, step on a barrier with about a lap to go and I knew he was tired. I had a lot left over so I knew I could finish strong.

I won the Penn Relays last year so I didn't want to go back that much. Frankly we came here because we sick of Penn a little bit. It's so much like cattle coming in and out and being held in the pen for half an hour before the race. Our coaches were not happy with the way athletes were treated. We wanted to try something new. I think Drake is a great meet. You don't know what you're missing until you try it.

Michael Johnson, Nike International: Winner 400-Meter Dash, Men's Spec. Invit. in 44.73

I just wanted to make a good showing today, see where I was with my training and then win the race. I feel I'm a lot further along than I was last year at this time.

It's good to come back to Drake. I ran here four years, mainly on relays. Now I'm on my own. It's really not as much fun now. I miss that team spirit.

My main focus now is to win the gold at the World Championships. I think it will take something in the 43.9 range. I have a lot of room for improvement in the 400. Any improvement in the 200 will be incremental. The 400 is something else. I'm glad I was able to run well here. It shows me that I'm about right where I want to be now.

Kevin Little, US West: 6th in 400-Meter Special Invit. in 46.77

I just never got into the race. At the 200 mark I tried to take off but I just couldn't stay with them. I was really tired at the end and that surprised me. I intended to use this race as training but I still wanted to run quicker. It's been a very busy weekend and I tried not to think about the race too much until today. This entire weekend has been a great experience and I want to thank Drake for honoring me as Grand Marshall. I'm very grateful.

Edith Nakiyingi, Iowa State: Winner Women's U-C 800-Meter Run in 2:06.17

I feel real happy to win all four in a row. I started out hard and nobody came with me so I slowed down. I wanted to run better than the record but I didn't have the competition. The wind didn't bother me at all.

Winning at the Drake Relays is always one of my major goals. Even four months away when I'm working out I'm thinking I have to push myself so I can do well at Drake. People are really into it here.

At this point I may just run the 800 at NCAAs. I haven't decided yet. I will run in Europe and then prepare for the World Championships.

Shaun Benefield, Mason City: Anchor on Winning High School Boys Sprint Medley Relay in 3:32.69.

The fact that this was my only race of the day helped a lot. I was well rested and ready to go. Really, winning this relay was the high point for me. I went out in a 400 pace because I knew it would take a lot to win. I felt it hurt at the 200 mark but I knew I could win. I made up my mind last night that I wanted to win.

Henry Brooks, Southwest Louisiana: Anchor on Winning University 4x400 Meter Relay in 3:03.51.

We wanted our shot at Baylor and today we got them. This is sweet revenge because we owed them. They beat us by .03 of a second at the Texas Relays and we came to Drake because they were coming here and because it is a bigger meet.

I am a come from behind runner and today fit that. In most races I make my move in the last 110 meters.

Devon Morris, Jamaica: Fourth place in the 400-Meter Dash, Men's Special Invitational in :46.19.

It (race) wasn't good for me. I felt tired after the first 200 meters. It could have been the seven hour ride up from St. Louis or something else. I don't know but the race just didn't feel good.

I respect Michael (Johnson) a lot. I guess you win some and you lose some. My relay team went to the Penn Relays but I wanted to come here because Drake is my place. The crowd gets into it and it is just a good place to run.

Raymond Pierre, Waco, Texas: Finished second in the 400-Meter Dash, Men's Special Invitational in :45.66.

Michael (Johnson) was coaching me the entire way. The race went very well since this is my first outdoor meet. Mike pushes me and I push him.

For me the rest of the season will be taken one step at a time. I want to make sure everything feels good and that I can work myself into decent condition.

Bill Payne, Baylor: Winner of University-College Pole Vault in 18-6 1/2, a new Drake Relays record.

I thought I could go over 19-0 today but I think I took too many jumps.

The crowd at the relays are great. They know and understand the pole vault and when you make a jump you hear from them. They really get into it.

I have been training pretty good. The yell I do at the start of each jump is something I have been doing since my freshman year. I think it gives me a little extra power.

John Nuttall, Iowa State: Winner of the University-College 1,500-Meter Run in 3:45.14.

We know we have a lot stronger team than last year and we are running a lot better as a result. Our team favors the distance side of track and we take pride in doing well especially here where we feel at home.

The local people give us a lot of encouragement and we field our best team because of that..

When you are running well, you get on a roll. We learn from one another as we go along in a season. The only thing wrong with today was the pace was too slow and that was disappointing. It took awhile to get going but when I found my groove things went as planned.

Rachel Lewis, Minnesota: Winner of Women's University and College Shot Put. She is a defending Drake Relays champion with a throw of 50-5 1/4.

I always get up for the relays. The meet is great but to tell you the truth today was not a very good meet for me. I am to the point where I am very tired and I need to take some time off.

I thought by this point in the season I would be throwing much better. I am looking forward to better throws and that will take preparation. Throwing the shot put and discus is physically demanding but a lot of it is mental as well.

Paul Ereng, Charlottesville, Va: Winner of 800-Meter Run, Men's Special Invitational in 1:46.82.

The race here is very special to me. I like running here because of the crowd and the surface is good.

I feel okay about the race today but for me right now it is a time of developing and getting ready for a heavier schedule of running. Every race is different, I take each one as they come.

Charles Lancon, Southwest Louisiana coach (after his team swept to victories in the 400, 800 and 1600 meter relays).

We didn't decide to come to the Drake Relays until a month ago. This is a great meet and well organized. The officials do a great job. The kids are fired up about coming back here next year. Our 1600 meter relay barely got beat by Baylor at the Texas Relays (3:06.64 -- 3:06.67).

Our ultimate goal today was to qualify for the NCAA in that event. We were ranked ninth provisionally going into this weekend but we secured the NCAA qualifying today.
