

# Gordien Throws Discus 181ft. 10in.

SANTA BARBARA, April 12—Fortune Gordien, world record holder in the discus throw, took a big stride in his comeback campaign here today when he tossed the platter 181ft. 10½in. in the Santa Barbara Relays.

The toss approached his world standard of 186ft. 11in., set in Finland in 1949. It also bettered the American record of 180ft. 2¾in.

## Beats Doyle

Gordien, former Minnesota star now competing for the Los Angeles AC, defeated Dick Doyle, the National AAU champ. Doyle, wearing the colors of the Montana AC, had a mark today of 169ft. 7in.

Only record set among the preps was by Leon Patterson of Taft, who added two full feet to his shot-put mark set last year. He did 58ft. 1½in. today.

Los Angeles Athletic Club won the team championship handily in the open division, scoring 85 points to the 37 for University of California, which placed second.

The LAAC mile relay team of Don Halderman, Sam Nicholson, Vern Trader and Roger Reinke was in fine form, establishing a new meet mark with a 3:16.8 victory.
