

NATIONAL PREP, JC SHOT RECORDS SET

SANTA BARBARA, April 4. The big boys took charge of the annual Easter Relays here this afternoon and evening, as national records were set in the high school and junior college shot-put.

In the daylight prep division Don Vick of Chaffey tossed the 12-pound ball 61ft. 7¼in., to better the record set last year by Taft's Leon Patterson by almost 10 inches. It was 60ft. 9¾in., and Vick equaled that last week in the Chaffey Invitational.

Besters Mark

The blond 6-foot 3-inch, 220-pound giant also had a toss of 61ft. 4in. this afternoon.

Then, under the arcs, Mason Benner, 240-pound Santa Monica City College behemoth, pitched the 16-pound bulb 52ft. 8¾in. to better the national JC standard by more than a foot. It was established at 51ft. 4¼in. last year by Clyde Wetter of Modesto JC.

Naturally, these also set new meet records. The old prep shot mark was 53ft., set by Vick last

year; the old Jaysee standard was 49ft. 1in., by John Stellern of Pasadena, also in 1952.

Olympic Games Champion Parry O'Brien also got his huge torso into the limelight with a heave of 56ft. 5in. to easily bag the open division. This was another meet mark, the old best being 55ft. 1½in. by Moose Thompson of the LAAC in 1949.

Patterson Sets Mark

Patterson, not to be overshadowed completely, got into the act by winning the JC-Frosh discus at 159ft. 3in., a new SC frosh record. He also placed second in the shot behind Benner.

Hugo Nutini of the host Santa Barbara school won the special open 880 in 1:56.9 with Ernie Amador, ineligible SC freshman, second.

Sim Iness of SC, who competed in the afternoon along with O'Brien against Occidental in Los Angeles, arrived too late to compete in the discus.

Another fine mark was hung up in the high school pole vault

when Ronnie Morris of Burroughs cleared 13ft. 6in.

As the night grew older the temperature grew colder and the marks became progressively slower.

The finals of the open 100-yard dash was won by Fresno's Les Laing in only 10.3 and the JC-Frosh century was won by Trojan Freshman Jim Decker in 10.4. He recently ran 9.7.

The San Diego Naval Training Center's finely balanced team took open division honors with 59 points to the Los Angeles AC's 33. The SC Frosh topped the Jaysee group with 33 7-12 points with Valley JC second at 24.
