

# Striders Capture Easter Relays

SANTA BARBARA, April 5—Fears that the weatherman would once again throw a monkeywrench into the running of the 20th annual Easter Relays were dispated here today as it came up clear and warm and the 620 athletes responded with a total of 10 meet records. Some 4000 fans attended.

The Southern California Striders, winning five events and tying in another, easily took team honors in the open division with 64 1/2 points. Oxy was second with 37 and UCLA third at 25.

## Mt. SAC Triumphs

In the junior college class, which had 27 schools, Mt. San Antonio took top honors with 401-7 digits to 281-7 for Harbor.

Brayton Norton of San Jose, winner of the open 100 in 8.6 and anchor on the Spartans' 440 relay team that tied the meet mark of 41.8, was named the outstanding performer.

Mike Larrabee of the Striders wasn't far behind. He anchored victorious 880 and mile baton teams, including a 47.5 anchor 440 in which the Striders set a record of 3:14.3. The Striders' clocking the 880 chase was 1:26.2.

## Range Sets Record

Veteran Roy Range came through on his last try to take the broad jump at 23ft. 1 1/2 in., another new mark. Joel Wiley of L.A. State had previously bettered the record of 24ft. 8 in. by 1 inch.

Bob Voiles, another Strider, got off a giant 249.5ft. javelin throw to overtake Oxy's Jon Jamison, who set a school record of 231.2ft. Only yesterday Jamison threw 220ft. 9 in. against UCLA and this afternoon teammate Dick Hollis did 221.7 to hold the Oxy mark for less than an hour.

Competing unattached, World Record Holder Bob Gutowski cleared 14ft. 11 1/2 in. in the pole vault for another new standard.

The fifth mark to fall came in the Nick Carter Mile, in which Hungarian Laszlo Taboet, representing the Santa Clara Youth Village, stepped 4:10.3. He did it in a most unorthodox manner, running the first quarter in 64, the half in 2:08.4 and then stepping the second half in 2:01.9.

## Jaysse Marks

The jaysse marks that toppled were in the high hurdles (twice), two-mile relay, broad jump, high jump and shot-put.

Although he didn't set a meet record, Bobby Avant of the SC freshmen tied for first in the open high jump with Strider Bob Fendler at 6ft. 8 1/2 in. and thereby upped his own Trobate mark.
