

# Carr Sparks Arizona State to 3:06.3 Mile Relay Mark

**SANTA BARBARA** — With some spectacular jet age momentum provided by Henry Carr, Arizona State smashed the mile relay mark at the 25th annual Easter Relays Saturday at La Playa Stadium with a 3:06.3 clocking.

Carr, the newly-crowned world record-holder in the 220 around a turn, blistered a second-leg 440 in 45.2 to break the back of what little opposition the Sun Devils expected. By the time anchorman Ullis Williams of Compton got the baton, it was strictly a race against the clock, half a lap in front of the field.

## New Meet Mark

Williams finished his stint in 46.1, which was good enough to break the meet mark of 3:10.6 set in 1962, but it fell short of their ambitions to break the world standard of 3:05.6.

As popular as the performance was, it took a back seat, sentimentally, in the hearts of the 9,500 spectators, to UCLA's C. K. Yang's heroic try at a world outdoor mark in the pole vault.

The Bruin ace outlasted an all-star field of John Uelses, Dave Tork and a surprising George Davies to win at 16 ft. ½ in.

## NCAA Record

Surprisingly, it did not break Uelses' year-old meet mark, but it did set an NCAA mark.

After beating the opposition, Yang set his sights on

16-4½, trying to better Northeast Louisiana's Don Pennel's mark of 16-3.

On his second leap, Yang appeared to have cleared the bar, but caught it on his chest on the way down—and that was as close as he got.

Yang was awarded the meet's top performance prize in a poll of sportswriters and got a standing ovation from the crowd.

## Webb Wins Mile

Tom Webb added another first place for the Bruins when he nipped Bob Seaman of the Los Angeles Track Club at the tape in the depleted field of the mile event.

The Bruin senior lunged and stumbled across the finish in 4:07.0.

Fans who came to the sunny seaside stadium expecting to see a massive assault on meet and international marks were disappointed for the most part.

Ralph Boston, former world record holder in the broad jump now competing for the Striders, failed to show, and miler Jim Grelle reserved himself for the distance medley relay, where he helped to give the Los Angeles Track Club a breezing 9:48.0, a new meet record.

## New Discus Record

Jay Silvester, competing unattached, broke the discus mark with a 194-2½ toss, but failed to take advantage of the sea breezes and go for a world mark.

Ernie Cunliffe ran a sizzling 1:49 flat 880, the best national mark this year, and

broke Ben Eastman's venerable 25-year-old mark of 1:52.7.

The Striders captured the 880 and two-mile relays in 1:25.4 and 7:37.0 and hometown hero, John Gilbert, now running for the Striders, won the 100 in 9.7.
