

Oregon St. Wins; Brubabe Zips 9.5

SANTA BARBARA—Terry Monroe's victory in the closing event, the triple jump, won the team championship for Oregon State in the 27th annual Easter Relays at La Palma Stadium Saturday.

UCLA owned a 49-47 lead before the hop event, but had no representative in it, so the Beavers were able to turn the tables by finishing either first or second—and Monroe made certain of the outcome with a leap of 47 feet, 9 inches.

Pepperdine took college division honors with 48 points.

Top Athlete

But all the collegians had to take a back seat to Bob Steinhoff of Downey's Warren High, who vaulted 16 feet, 1 inch to be voted unanimously as athlete of the meet.

Cold wind and a chewed-up track hindered most performances, and limited attendance to an estimated 5,000.

Norm Jackson, former Air Force sprint champion who now is a freshman at UCLA, won the 100 in 9.5 to equal the meet record set way back in 1935 by Frank Wykoff and later matched by Ray Norton and Bob Poynter.

Jackson had an aiding wind of 4.2 m.p.h., which was under the allowable limit.

School Mark

Another Bruin Fresh, Don Domansky, was clocked in 46.6 as anchor of the mile relay combine that led the varsity and Oregon State to the wire in 3:14.1, a school yearling record.

Anticipated fireworks in the two-mile relay fizzled. UCLA got a big early lead on Oregon State and won breezing in 7:30.4 to 7:38.8 for OSU. Bruin anchor man Bob Day eased up for a 1:50.9 time, while his opposite number, Morgan Groth, did 1:50.5, after getting the baton far back.

The high-jumping duel between Olympians John Rambo of Cal State at Long Beach and Ed Caruthers of Santa Ana College went to the former at 6-9½ to 6-7½.

Tracy Smith of Oregon State, one-time state mile champion at Arcadia, captured the two-mile run in the good time of 9:00.6.
