

# Trojans Breeze in Easter Relays; UCLA's Ostoich Hurls Shot 61-9 $\frac{3}{4}$

SANTA BARBARA —

The national collegiate track champions from USC probably won't have it any easier in a dual meet this year than they did Saturday in winning nine of 14 events at the 31st annual Easter relays.

The Trojans scored 82 points to 38 for runnerup California, 30 for Stanford, 24 for Arizona and 19 for an eight-man token UCLA team. Host UC Santa Barbara defeated NCAA college division champion Cal Poly (SLO), 37 $\frac{1}{2}$  to 30, in the college class.

Despite the superiority of coach Vern Wolfe's Trojan powerhouse, it remained for Dennis Savage of Westmont and Mark Ostoich of UCLA to produce the day's outstanding individual performances.

Savage, a senior at the local school, won the open mile in 4:06.5, then came back with a

1:51.7 anchor half-mile to lead Westmont to a 7:36.6 two-mile relay win. Westmont's winning time, a college division meet record, was faster than USC's 7:39.4 made in winning the university division.

Athlete of the Meet honors were voted Savage, who prepped at nearby San Marcos High. It was a popular choice for the 6,000 fans who watched the meet on an ideal spring day.

Ostoich, a 245-pound sophomore from San Bernardino, hurled the shot 61-9 $\frac{3}{4}$  to hand teammate Steve Marcus his first intercollegiate loss since 1967. Marcus, last year's NCAA champion, was second at 59-10 $\frac{1}{2}$ .

Ostoich's mark, an improvement of more than three feet over his freshman school record of 58-5, sets up the finest college shot put duel in history next Saturday when Kansas brings three 60-footers

to Westwood to meet the Bruins.

Lennox Miller led the USC parade, winning the 100 in 9.5 after tying the meet record of 9.4 in his heat, and anchoring both the 440 and 880 relay victories. Miller first set the relays record in 1966, starting a string of four USC sprint victories, including those by O. J. Simpson (1967) and Fred Kuller (1968).

Kuller was second Saturday in 9.6 and also ran on both sprint relays with Rich Coulter and Ron Pharris.

Despite a slow 50.3 opening lap by Mike Newton, the Trojans set a relays record in the distance medley of 9:45.9, breaking a mark set in 1963 by a Los Angeles Track Club foursome anchored by Jim Grelle. Outstanding relay legs were run by Rich Joyce (1:51.9) and Carl Trentadue (2:55.3), followed by Ole Oleson's 4:08.3 mile for the record.
