## Eashman Faints; FWC Title to Sac

SACRAMENTO — Sacramento State won the Far Western Conference track championship last night in a meet marred by the collapse of Hayward State distance star Willie Eashman.

Eashman, a Washington High grad and one of the best distance runners to come out of San Francisco, had already won the mile in 4:07 and was at the half-way point in the 880 when he collapsed.

His breathing had to be restored by UC-Davis trainer Dick Lewis and he then was rushed to Sacramento Medical Center where a preliminary diagnosis was described as a bronchial attack. The hospital reported late last night that Eashman's pulse and blood pressure were normal.

Sacramento State may have won the meet because of Eashman's blackout. The Hornets edged Hayward State, 150-144, and Eashman only had to finish third to collect six more points for his team.

The meet was moved to Sacramento State from UC-Davis because of bad weather, although sloppy conditions at the SSC track still accounted for bad marks.
