## UCD Women Win Six Events But Trail Chico

DAVIS — The University of California at Davis and favored California State University at Hayward each won six events, but CSU-Chico used its depth to win the team title of the Northern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Women's Track and Field Championships yesterday at Toomey Field.

Chico piled up 89 points to 60 for the Aggies and 51 for Hayward while UC Berkeley finished last in the four-team field with 29.

Chico received wins from Vanita Walters in the 100-yard dash and Jan Basich in the long jump and won the 440-relay in 50.1, but relied on nine second place finishes to win the 16-event meet.

Aggie Eileen Claugus, a

freshman from Sacramento, turned in a distance double when she won the mile in 5:05.2 — her best of the year - then returned little more than an hour later to take the two mile in 11:20.6.

The meet's only other double winner was UCD's Leslie Clark, who won the 100-meter hurdles in 16.1, the 400-meter hurdles in 1:04.4 and teamed with Cattie Cox, Lynne Vogensen and Carolyn Tiernan to win the mile relay in a season best 4:00.6.
