

Wildcat Gals Win Trackfest

BERKELEY (E-R)—Depth enabled Chico State University's women's track and field team to win its fourth straight Northern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championship here over the weekend.

It was a close meet with Chico State edging runnerup UC Davis 75-72. Host UC Berkeley trailed with 61 points while Hayward State tallied 31 and Humboldt State eight.

The shot put was the deciding event. Chico State had three competitors in the finals while UC Davis had only one. Jan Schenck placed second in that event.

Chico State won only three of the 17 events but the Wildcats placed second or third in 13 events and those points were very important.

Sheila Hamilton took the 100 hurdles in :15.3. Kathy McQuillan set a championship record of 5-3 while taking the high jump.

Chico State's other victory was the 440 relay. Hamilton, Michelle DeVol, Renda Cary and Cindy Mik teamed up to set a championship and league record of :49.0 in the win.

Seven Wildcat competitors and coach Cherrie Sherard will leave Sunday for Manhattan (Kansas) for the Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women national championships.
