## Cummings has tests on heart

CHICAGO (UPI) — San Diego Clippers forward Terry Cummings has been released from Northwestern Memorial Hospital after undergoing a series of tests on his heart.

The former DePaul University star, who was sent home Saturday, entered the hospital April 22 complaining of dizzy spells and shortness of breath. A heart monitor detected an irregular heart beat.

Clippers General Manager Paul Phipps said the cause of the irregular heart beats and fatigue that knocked the 6-foot-9 Cummings out of his last six games this season was being taken care of by medication.

Tom Collins, Cummings' agent, said his client would undergo a heart biopsy sometime later this summer.

"He's on medication now that seems to be working, but it is important that we have all the tests done before he tries to play again," Collins said. ■
