

Riverside Quartet Wins Chaffey Meet, Gate City Is Third

ONTARIO, March 13.—Forced to buck the elements which sent a typical "Santa Ana" storm sweeping over the Chaffey oval and to battle for places with the cream of track and field athletes from 15 Southern California high schools, Patton, Akers, Carnahan and Campbell, the "four horsemen" of the Riverside Polytechnic high school, rode to victory with a score of 30 points in the first annual Chaffey invitational track and field meet held this afternoon on the Chaffey Union high school oval.

In the battle for second place, the Chaffey tracksters nosed out Coach A. F. Schaefer's San Bernardino Cardinals by a score of 21½ points to 20½ points. Santa Ana high finished fourth with 17 points. Other schools to finish in the scoring column were Huntington Beach, 9; Brawley, 8; El Centro, 7 1-3; Redlands, 6 1-3; Fullerton, 6 1-3; Tustin 4; Pomona, 4; Chino, 3; Harvard Military, 3.
