

# FIVE RECORDS SHATTERED IN TWO DIVISIONS

Saints Score 44 Points While  
South Pasadena Gets Second  
Place on 24 1/2 Points

ONTARIO, March 26.—Three open and two novice records were established during the annual Chaffey Invitational today which the Santa Ana high school won on a total of 44 points.

The Saints came through as predicted and won by a good margin of points over their closest competitors. The South Pasadena high school team was second on a total of 24 1-2 points and Huntington Beach was third with 20 3-8 points. The Chaffey Tigers, runners up in the 1939 invitational, ranked fourth today against the keenest competition of the annual track and field meet. The Tigers chalked up a total of 17 1-2 points.

Captain Paul, of Santa Ana, was the high point man of the meet, scoring a total of 15 points. He further distinguished himself by lowering the 220-yard low hurdles, running the distance in 24 seconds to chip off two seconds from the previous mark.

Chaffey won the trophy for having the highest number of point winners—seven men.

The outstanding record of the day was made in the novice division in which the high jump was raised 2 1-8 inches to 5 feet, 10 3-8 inches. This was an inch and a quarter higher than the senior division.

In the open meet, the Class A relay was lowered from 1:34.5 to 1:32.7; and the high jump record went up from 5 feet, 8 1-8 inches, to 5 feet 8 1-4. Of the novice events, the 44-yard race was reduced .7 second with San Bernardino a close second.
