

Tigers, Cardinals Win Laurels In Annual Chaffey Invitational

ONTARIO, April 18. — Coach "Pop" Kegley's strong Chaffey high school Tigers won the Chaffey invitational track and field crown today from a field of brilliant contestants representing the leading prep schools of the Southland. The winners scored 26 points while South Pasadena high school placed second with 24 digits. Harvard military academy, of Los Angeles won third place honors with 17 markers.

Coach Victor Hodge's San Bernardino athletes failed to show much in the open events but completely outclassed the novice field scoring 26 points followed closely by South Pasadena with 25 points. Chaffey annexed third honors. This win for San Bernardino was the second consecutive victory, as they triumphed in 1930.

Colton high school's aggregation scored 63-5 points during the open events and seven markers in the novice class. Redlands obtained 10 points in the novice and accounted for but two points in the open numbers.

Dave Meek, versatile star of the Tigers, tied with Spurr of South Pasadena for high point honors both scoring 10 points. Meek won the open shot put with a toss of 51 feet 9 7/8 inches to break the mark made by Nelson Gray of Chaffey in 1929. Meek then won the open high jump at 6 feet 1/2 inch to shatter the mark of Jacques of Santa Ana, made last year. Spurr won both open dashes setting a new mark in the century at 10-1-5 seconds.

Rand, of Harvard set a new mark in the pole vault with a boost over the bar of 12 feet 6 inches. This replaces the mark made in 1929 by Graber, of Chaffey. Lyon, of South Pasadena set a new high hurdle mark during the morning trials but failed to place in the afternoon due to disqualification. However he was awarded the new record at 15.6 seconds.

The good performance turned in by athletes of Chaffey, San Bernardino, and South Pasadena, who finished second in both divisions, was the feature of the meet. Track officials and visiting coaches were loud in their praise for the work of starter-referee Hugh Welsh of Los Angeles.
