

# CARDS SECOND TO WHITTIER IN TRACK MEET AT CHAFFEY

## Redbirds Fourth in Novice Division Of Classic

San Bernardino high school came within two and one-half points of winning the open championship in yesterday's annual Chaffey invitational track meet.

As it was, Whittier won the title with 21½ points, while Vic Hodge's Cards were second with 19 points.
