

COVINA WINS INVITATIONAL

Covina high school's crack track and field team, displaying scoring strength in most events, took home the 17th annual Chaffey invitational title Saturday afternoon at Ontario, competing against 33 other schools of the Southland. Corona high won the novice meet.

Pomona high was completely shut out of the varsity meet, but little Bill Koenig, Emerson junior high school sprint star, saved the Red Devils from complete disgrace by romping in for a win in the 100-yard dash and second in the 220-yard dash of the novice meet. Ken Lunde, broadjump ace, was too crippled to perform up to standard, and may be thru for the season. Besides football injuries suffered last fall, he is recovering from a fractured leg suffered while skiing.

Covina's Colts scored 26½ points to 21 for the second place El Monte team, while Bonita Bearsate took third place with 18 and Colton fourth with 15½ points.

Glenn Davis, Bonita's sprint king, won a 17 seconds flat 100-yard dash and also took first in a 21.9 seconds 220 yard dash for individual honors in the meet. Bonita's 440 ace, Paul Shamblin, was another winner in the meet, and Ralph Davis, Glenn's twin brother, took second in the shotput against the only prep in the Southland who could turn the trick, Jim Shipkey of Anaheim.

Corona had 30½ points for top honors in the novice meet. Excelsior was second with 14, Burbank third with 11.
