Chaffey Invitational Meet

Devils Finish Fourth in Open Division

Sparked by the twin victories of Bob Cornelison in the 100 and 200 yard dashes, Coach George Hodger's San Bernardino Cardinals swept both the open and novice divisions of the annual 30-team Chaffey Invitational track festival last Saturday at Ontario. In the open division the Cardinals noosed out Fullerton, their nearest competitor, 30 1/2 - 28 1/8, and slipped past Coachella, 19-18 in the novice field.

Coach Ed Adams' Pomona high school Red Devils fared remarkably well in the open division, finishing fourth without the services of Truman Cade, Don Fleming, and Don Nunnley. The Red Devil novice squad finished sixth.

Hicks First in 440

Charles "Haggy" Hicks blazed to victory in the second heat of the 440 after finishing a close fourth in the 100 while team-mate Bob Simon outpaced all opposition to win the open mile by 20 yards over San Bernardino's Jess Zaragoza.

In the morning preliminaries both Hicks and Cornelison glided to easy 10.1 victories in the century but in the afternoon finals seemed to have lost some of their speed with the San Bernardino speedster winning in a surprising 10.3.

Hicks broke from the post in the 440 in the lead and battled it out with Berdon's Stacy Miles until the final 100 yards when the Devil ace began to pull away. Simon on the other hand trailed until the third lap when he began to pour on the stuff and won handily.

Devil Novices Score

Red Devil novice points were scored by Bob Richardson, George Lehman, Dale Bluthman, and the relay team. Richardson finished third in the 200 and Lehman did likewise in the 200. Bluthman finished in a three-way tie for fourth and the relay team composed of Charles Nelson, Siegler, Richardson, and Lehman took first in their heat.

Fremont junior high school also gave a good showing for themselves and in particular Don McCallan. Again as in the open bracket McCallan ran his heat three faster than those scored in the finals but was still ahead at the finish of both the 100 and 200.
