

# Chaffey Spike Meet Halted At Half Mark

The annual Chaffey Invitational spikefest was interrupted by rain half-way through Saturday, but not until Compton High had rolled up a commanding lead to virtually assured of the title.

The Tarbabes tallied 28 points in the Open class to Fullerton's 9½, Colton's 9, 8 for Chaffey and Riverside and 6 for San Bernardino. The meet resumes at 3 p.m. on April 30, officials announced.

Santa Ana High led the Novice class with 14 1/3, followed by Grossmont 12, Covina 7½, Redlands 6, San Bernardino 5 1/6 and Chaffey 4½.

Big Don Vick shattered John Raitt's shot put record of 53-10 set back in 1935 when he tossed the 12-lb. bulb 55-11½. Bronson of Grossmont also broke the Novice shot record.

The other Open mark was set by Compton's Fernando Ledesma, who won in 4:28.9 to best Pomona's Bob Simon's 4:32.2 set in 1949. Herman Gallardo and Dan Castruita of SBHS ran 3-4 in the second mile, won by Chino's Delgado in 4:36.9.

Kenny Moore of Colton was fourth in a 10.1 100 and won one 440 race in 53.2. SBHS's Don Kordyak was second in the faster 51.6 440. The Cards' Bob Turner and Manuel Gonzales were 2-4 in a 22-11 broad jump.

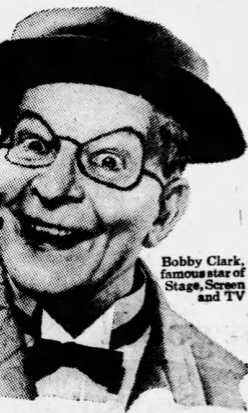

# COMPTON, SANTA ANA IN SPIKE WINS AT CHAFFEY

Compton High rolled up 54 points to spread-eagle the Open Division, and Santa Ana compiled 27 1/7 to edge Redlands in the Novice, as the Chaffey Invitational concluded Wednesday at Ontario.

Fullerton was runnerup to Compton with 26, while Chaffey's 14 and San Bernardino's 10 paced CBL efforts in the Open. Coach Bob Scholton's Terriers and Grossmont tied for second with 17 and Colton had 9 in the Novice.

Two records toppled. Compton's Carter cleared 12-10½ to crack the 12-9½ mark by South Pasadena's Vanderhoof in 1942. Santa Ana's soph 880 quartet won in 1:34.5, lowering the 1:35.4 set 14 years ago by another Saint foursome.

Alex Loustaunau, a ninth grade Colton star, won the Novice 880, and Stan Gray of Redlands took the low hurdles in 14.2. The classy Redlands relayers, minus CBL 220 king Denny White, ran a close third in a fast 1:32.8. SBHS Coaches John Grenfell and Bob Tanner kept their qualifiers out for Saturday's CIF meet at Riverside.
