

Swisshelm And Vick Set Marks

Chaffey High's shot putting perfectionist, Don Vick, and Santa Ana's Bullet Ball Swisshelm made prep track history in the 37th annual Chaffey Invitational yesterday at Ontario where Santa Ana won the team championship for the first time since 1939.

Vick equalled the national interscholastic record for the 12-pound shot with a mighty put of 60 ft., 9 1/2 inches. He had three other heaves more than 60 feet.

Swisshelm, the Saints' sensational junior sprinter, spread-eagled the field in the 100 and 220, stopping the watches in 9.8 sec. and 21.2 sec. He also anchored Santa Ana's victorious half-mile relay team.

Swisshelm's 9.8 "hundred" was a new Chaffey Meet record as well as an all-time Santa Ana High School mark. His 21.4 sec. 220 (made in the morning preliminaries) will count as a new school record too. He was favored by a breeze at his back in the afternoon finale when he sped the distance in 21.2.

Santa Ana scored 26 points to dethrone Compton, which was tied for second place by Riverside with 18. San Bernardino, Bellflower and Pomona tied for fourth with 13.

Pomona took the Sophomore division with 23, followed by Riverside with 22 3/5 and Fullerton 14 1/10.

Santa Ana's team total resulted from Swisshelm's two firsts in the 100 and 220; Jack McCosh's first in the 180 low hurdles in 19.8 (another school record) and his third in the high hurdles; the relay team's first with McCosh, George Spelman, Charley Neal and Swisshelm racing 1:31.8; Neal's third in the broad jump at 21 ft. 1 1/4 in. and the fourth in the 440, and Don Green's fourth in the mile at 4:52.

Another standout performance came from Orange's great quarter-miler, Landon Carter, who won without opposition in 49.4 sec., missing the long-time meet record by only five-tenths.
