

STORY FAILS IN TRY FOR U.S. MILE MARK

ONTARIO, April 11—After a new national high school mile record attempt missed by a mile, two big upsets proved to be the "story" of the 33rd Chaffey Invitational today.

Little-known Jan Underwood of Buena Park whipped Bellflower's favored Larry Canova in a 1:56.4 880 and Coachella's Garry Crystal, virtually unheard of before this meet, spread-eagled a 220 field that included La Habra's Pat Moore, with a 21.0 new meet record clocking. Moore, second, had the same time.

The highlight of the carnival was supposed to have been the mile. In that race, such runners as Leroy Neal of Fullerton and El Cajon's Jack Hudson were to have pushed Dale Story (4:15.1) of Orange close to the national mark (4:13.2).

Bulky Field

But the bulky, sluggish field scotched the effort at the start with a 66.0 first lap. No one seemed willing to push or pace Story and he loped along to a 4:22.4 clocking that just barely broke the meet record.

The 100 was a corker. Three runners finished in 9.7 with California's Buddy Fitzgerald getting the nod over Moore (2nd) and San Bernardino's John Howard. It was a record tying mark.

Other record performances were by Paul Stuber of Bellflower, who cleared 6ft. 6in., and Bob Maimbourg of Garden Grove with a 13ft. 6in. vault. Team title went to California (22) over second-place Chaffey (17½).
