

# Compton's Ulis Williams Blazes to 47.3 in Quarter-Mile at Chaffey

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ONTARIO, April 2—Long-striding Ulis Williams of Compton emerged from the Chaffey Track Invitational as a solid threat to break the national interscholastic 440 record when he outstripped his quarter-mile competition in 47.3 today.

The mark was the fifth best 440 ever run by a high schooler in the United States.

Williams' coach, Ernst Hartmann, predicts his star will smash the national prep record of 46.6 set by Ohio's Dave Mills last season. And the Tarbabe flash has over a year to work on it—he's only a junior.

## 'The Greatest'

"He's by far the greatest quarter-miler I've ever coached," says Hartmann, a veteran of 29 seasons at Compton. "His potential can't be measured. With the added maturity one more season will give him you just can't set a limit on what he might do."

The race by Williams, 6-0, 170, was the best by a prep in the nation this year and the all-time best for a junior.

Ahead of Williams on the all-time list are the following, who chalked up their marks as seniors: Mills (46.6), Jerry White (Corcoran, 46.7, 1956), Ollie Matson (San Francisco, 47.1, 1948) and Eddie Southern (Texas, 47.2, 1955). The marks by Matson

and Southern came in open competition.

Williams' performance "made" the meet, but it wasn't the only fine result. Three other meet records were shattered. And Compton, flaunting its great depth, won the team title with 41 points.

In the novice 880, sophomore Bob Delaney of Orange stole the thunder away from La Habra's Bruce Bess by scampering to a record 1:58.0 clocking. In a separate half-mile race Bess, a 4:20.5 miler, was timed in 2:01.2.

Another mark fell in the open 880 where Buena Park's classy Jan Underwood won in 1:55.0, a national prep best.

And Compton's 880 relay team of Leon Vaughn, Woody Prude, Johnny Walker and John Moore was caught in 1:28.2. Castlemont of Oakland has done 1:27.1.
