

Seagren Vaults 14-8½ at Chaffey Meet

Records Fall As Compton Scores Win

ONTARIO—Bob Seagren of Pomona High vaulted 14-8½ here Saturday afternoon to highlight action in the 37th annual Chaffey Invitational Track and Field Meet.

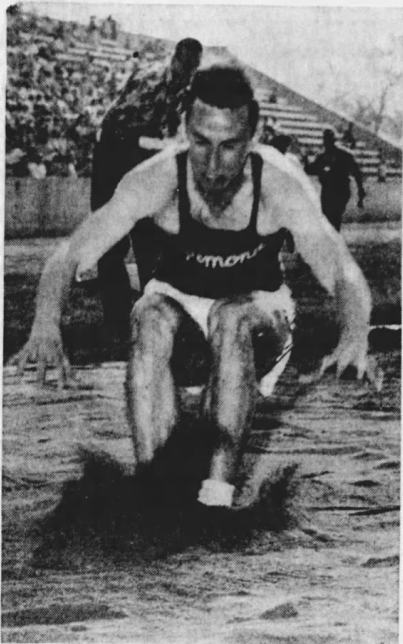
Compton won the individual team championship with 26 points, followed by Corona 22, Chaffey 19 and Colton 19. Pomona finished with 14 points.

SEAGREN CLEARED 14-8½ on his first attempt for a new meet record. He then tried 15-2½ but failed in his bid for a new national prep standard.

Other top performances were turned in by Roger Moody of Corona, Ken Mode of Compton and Bob Bonds of Riverside Poly as each established new meet records.

Moody breezed to a 13.9 clocking in the high hurdles but placed second in the lows. Moody has a best of 13.8 this year. Mode cleared 6-7¼ in the high jump while Bonds set a new mark in the broad jump at 23-11¼ and tied the century record of 9.7.

Steve Davis of Ganesha won both novice sprints in times of 10.1 and 22 flat. Ron Burns of Montclair finished second in the 100.

COMPTON ALSO captured the novice division with 20½ points. Ganesha and Chaffey picked up 10 points apiece.

In the open 440 Spenser Williams of Chaffey streaked to a 48.2 clocking, the best in the CIF this year. The meet record is 47.3, set by Ullis Williams in 1960.

Doug Westlake of Pomona placed third in the third quarter-mile race. Westlake also took a fourth in the broad jump and anchored the Red Devil relay team that finished third.

The three 880 races produced excitement for the fans as Chaffey's Chuck Ferguson, Colton's Walt Channels and Compton's Devore Smith recorded winning marks of 1:55.9, 1:55.7 and 1:54.4. Ferguson's time set a new Tiger school record as he topped his previous mark of 1:57.2. Smith entered the meet with a season best of 1:53, which is Dennis Carr's meet record.

BEN GONZALES of Corona won the Fischer Mile Trophy for his 4:25.4 effort. Mike Seamons of Bellflower, who entered with a season best of 4:21.1, won his race in 4:26.0.

Roger Cox of Redlands came back to win the 220 in 21.3 after being upset in the 100.

Three new records were set in the novice division. John Vaughn of Corona cleared 13-6 to smash the old pole vault mark by 11½ inches.

Gary Lehmer of Loara tossed the shot 52-4½ while Randy Henry of Eisenhower won the 880 in 2:00. This marked the first time the 880
