

Ravens win 5th straight HCAC title: Anderson University men's track team claimed its fifth straight Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference track and field championship. Ravens' coach Larry Maddox earned his seventh conference coach of the year award. Cliff Goss of Anderson was voted track events MVP winning the 100 meter dash, 110 high hurdles and the 400 intermediate hurdles. Teammate Chris Renn's earned the MVP award in the field events winning the discus as well as the shot put, where he set a new conference record.
