DEFIANCE, Ohio - The Anderson University men's track team ran away with its seventh consecutive HCAC championship Saturday, but a bigger story was the AU women finishing second by three points to the host school.

"Our women's team performance was one of the best I have coached," AU coach Larry Maddox said.

The women were picked in the middle of the pack and were missing all-conference runner Lisa Nicholson, but they nearly upset Defiance, falling by three points (143 1/2-139 1/2).

Amber Sigler was named the HCAC Track MVP after winning the 3,000, 5,000 and 10,000-meter races. Kenese Jenkins won both the discus and javelin despite competing with a torn rotator cuff. Other winners were Latishia Horrell (Hammer), Amanda Wright (400) and the 400 relay team. All four were named all-conference.

The men beat Defiance by 67 points to win their seventh straight HCAC title. Jason Kolkmeier was named the HCAC Track MVP and David Jackson was the HCAC Field MVP. Kolkmeier won both hurdles events and the triple jump. Jackson won the hammer and shot put. Alex Gill (400), Brian Miller (1,500), Jason Medler (5,000 and 10,000), Michael Watts (3,000 steeplechase) and Adam Atkinson (pole vault) also won events and were named all-conference.

"In both the men's and women's teams we ask a great deal of our athletes as they were competing in multiple events throughout the day," Maddox said. "They performed very well."
