

Record After Record Falls as Result of Competition

Irish Garner 55 1-10 Points—Purdue Second, Depauw Third, Wabash Fourth, Earlham Fifth, Indiana University Sixth

LAFAYETTE, Ind., May 29.—Notre Dame's well balanced team placed in every event at the Indiana intercollegiate track and field meet on Stuart Field, Purdue University today and won with a total of 55 1-10 points. Purdue was second with 28 1-10 points and DePauw was third with 20. The other teams finished as follows:

Wabash, 16 3-5; Earlham, 16; Franklin, 15 3-5; Butler, 6; American Gymnastic Union, 5; Franklin, 2.

Purdue won the mile relay race which was one of the features of the meet.

Flye state records were broken and two were tied. Burke of Notre Dame set a new mark for the mile, after nosing out Furnas of Purdue in the last twenty feet. His time was 4 minutes 21 2-5 seconds. The former record was held by Ikey Myers of DePauw at 4 minutes 24 4-5 seconds.

Kasper of Notre Dame ran the quarter mile in 49 4-5 seconds, beating the record held by Jerry East of Purdue at 51 1-5 seconds.
