LAFAYETTE, Ind., May 29.—Notre Dame's well balanced team placed in every event at the Indiana intercollegiate track and field meet on Straut Field, Purdue University today and won with a total of 55 1:10 points. Purdue was second with 23 1:10 points and DePauw was third with 20. The other teams finished as follows:

Purdue won the mile relay race which was one of the features of the meet.

Five state records were broken and two were tied. Burke of Notre Dame set a new mark for the mile, after nosing out Furnas of Purdue in the last twenty feet. His time was 4 minutes 21 2-5 sec. onds. The former record was held by lkey Myers of DePauw at 4 minutes 24 4-5 seconds.
