ARMY WINS HEPTAGONALS

Princeton, New Jersey, Feb. 26: The Army scored a mild surprise by winning the Indoor Heptagonal Championships. Led by Kathy Harrison's twin win in the 55 and 200, the Cadets won easily with 127 points. Pennsylvania was next in line with 78.

Harvard's Kate Wiley had an excellent 16:31.17 clocking for the 5k and the meet featured some strange timings in the 800 as three runners were under 2:07 in the heats, yet the winning time in the final was 2:12.46. Princeton's Marge DeMarrais finished next to last (9th) in the final in 2:19.10 yet was credited with 2:06.40 in her heat.
