1992 TAC/USA National Junior Championships

The Ohio State University - Saturday July 4th & Sunday July 5th

This annual national championship, open to athletes age 19 and under, is used to pick members of the U.S. Junior National Championship team for a series of summer competitions, with this year's program culminating in September's World Junior Championships in Seoul, South Korea. A number of Californians were in attendance, with Marion Jones leading a number of Golden Staters who will achieve the highest honor for an American teenager, wearing a U.S.A. jersey in international competition as a representative of our nation. The very interesting combination of preps and first year collegians that take part in this meet always creates some great events, with the 1992 Meet its usual number high quality marks and great competitive races and field events.

Marion Jones, who after the Olympic Trials decided that making a U.S. team for sure at this level was better than tagging along to Europe with no guarantee of a spot in the big Barcelona Meet, led California's six winners with 100 and 200 meter victories. Marion realized fans' expectations early in Saturday's portion of the meet, blasting a Stadium 100 meter record with her 11.30 (wind +1.2) semifinal win. Later the same day Jones dominated a strong Finals group, winning by two meters at 11.33 (+0.4) over National Scholastic Outdoor star Benita Kelley (South Carolina) 11.52 and old namesis, Zundra Feagin (Unat, UNLV), who you may remember was the Florida prep who was the Track & Field News Prep Athlete of the Year that Marion took in her first National Prep Record, a 22.87 200m in the 1991 Arcadia Invitational. Marion took the 200 on Sunday, with a 23.14w (+3.4) semi win and and 22.94 (+0.3) final effort, the latter a Meet Record. Lesa Parker (Unat, Bishop O'Dowd HS, Oakland) continued a super senior year, with the Arizona State-bound star racing a pr 11.61 for fourth in the 100. Ricky Carrigan (Unat, Compton JC) dominated a good Men's 200 meter group,

taking the Final at 20.94 (wind +0.1) by two meters. Ricky pulled a hamstring seriously in this meet last year in the 100 Finals after blasting a 10.29 Semifinal win, so his victory here had a certain sweetness to it.

Californians were prominent in the distance events. In the Men's 1500m, Richie Boulet (Sacramento TC/UC Berkeley), blazed a final 400 in the low 58 second range to take 3:48 University of Oregon frosh star, Tracy Hollister, 3:53.74-3:54.57, with San Marcos HS of Santa Barbara prep (interestingly Villanova-bound), Todd Tressler, third at 3:46.92. It was "instant replay" in the Women's 3000m, as the race unfolded just as the California State prep affair at Cerritos had a month earlier. Milena Glusac (San Diego TC/Failbrook HS) took the event out, holding a 40-50 meter lead through the first four laps, where Maribella Aparicio (Fillmore HS) started to edge away from the second pack towards the San Diego area star. Closing to within 20 meters with two laps to go, Glusac pressed the pace as she had in the State High School competition, pulling away and winning 9:48.23-9:59.99 over Maribella, with the California duo making the U.S. Junior team and able to pick up some great end of junior year experience to send them into their senior campaigns.

Laura Hayward (Future TC/Agoura HS) was second in the Women's 10,000m, stringing three consecutive 12:10 3200's without rest plus one lap to a 38:04.40 clocking and U.S. Junior team membership. A big surprise in the distances was Alisa Nicodemus, a frosh at Utah State, who last year was a 5:09.8 1600m runner (39th on the 1991 California yearly list) at Grossmont HS in La Mesa. The victim of "rotate coaching" (walk-ons who changed everytime she looked around in High School), Alisa became the state's most improved distance runner in 1992 with her 4:30.91 here for second in the 1500m. Robin Snowbeck (Santa Monica TC/University (L.A.) HS) was fourth in the same event at 4:40.05. Mike Terry, coming back from an injury that resulted in him redshirting his frosh year at UCLA, looked good over 800m, racing 1:50.99 in a good Finals race for 4th. Prep Mike Katri (Fortuna), University of Oregon-bound, and seemingly a candidate for a great college career, was welcomed to the traffic of a college level race in the 800 finals, placing 5th in 1:51.65. Steve Guerrini, former Santa Rosa HS star, now a frosh at Wake Forest (don't any of these California distance runners stay at home for their collegiate careers??) was second in the steeple-chase at 9:19.74.

Californians were a big factor in the Women's field events, with a number making the U.S. Junior team with placings among the top two. Kayla Mont-

gomery (Clovis West HS, Fresno) had a pr in the Triple Jump at 40-11 3/4 (wind +1.5) for second. Kristin Heaston (Sacramento TC/Ygancio Valley HS, Concord) was barely beaten in the Shot Put by UCLA-bound Missouri prep star Valyeta Althouse 47-9 3/4-47-9 1/4. Leslie Coons (Mesa CC, San Diego) was scond in the javelin at 148-8. Mindy Wirtz (Medina HS, Ohio), but a Californian the first two years of her prep career at Leland HS in San Jose. took the Discus with a fifth round 160-7 to edge Suzy Powell (Sacramento TC/Downey HS, Modesto) soph 158- 9. Katrina Bindel (Wake Forest), a great all-arounder from Eureka HS, showed fine improvement during her first year of college, scoring 5228 for second in the Heptathlon.

Top Men's field event for Californians was the Long Jump, with Derek Scurry (Cal State Northridge) 24-5 1/2w (+3.5) third, Roque Belina (UC

Irvine, probably the last male competitor ever for that program) fourth at 24-3 1/2w (+2.5) (23-8 1/4 wind legal), and Edward Turner (Morningside HS, Inglewood) 5th at 23-5 1/2w (+6.4)

Shon Lewis (Wilcox HS, Santa Clara), a junior, picked up some good national experience, with a 10.66 for 7th in the Men's 100. Erin Blunt (San Pasqual HS, Escondido), UCLA-bound, was a 100 meter high hurdle (33" versus the 30" California preps run) semifinal winner at 14.35, then raced 14.36w under wet track condtions in the finals for 6th. Hesperian Liz Sutton, racing her colelgiate frosh season at El Camino CC, was 4th in the Finals of the 400 meter low hurdles at 60.97. David Loshonkohl (Mesa CC, San Diego) was 3rd in the Hammer at 173-6 with prep Jeremy Robinson (Explorer Post 813/ Bellarmine HS, San Jose) next at 169-

Susan Armenta, a Riverside area prep now attending University of Wisconsin at Parkside, set an American and Meet Record in the 5000m walk at 24:33.07. Saddest "sure-thing" of the meet was Chris Olsson-O'Neill, who had been over 7-2 1/4 in the High Jump as a frosh at Cal State Los Angeles, but was faced with wet conditions after a bit of rain Sunday afternoon and could not get over his 6-8 1/4 opening height. Marcus Stokes, the fine Hurdler from small Thacher HS in Ojai, who will be attending North Field Mt. Hermon prep school in Massachusetts for a year before starting his collegiate career, was a fine 4th in the Highs at 14.85.
