MEET SPOTLIGHT

Walnut, California - Friday, June 23rd -

Saturday, June 24th.

Despite an entry blank that was out very late (mid-May), with the resulting failure to promote the meet during the late winter and spring that held possible participation down, a surprsingly successful Junior Championships were held in California in Walnut in late June. Many of California's prep and first year college stars were in attendance, with a wet spring probably leaving locals a bit more hungry for top-level compettion at this time of year than most others. The first two athletes in all events (except Girls Pole Vault and Hammer) would make the U.S. Pan American Junior team for that competition later this summer in Santiago, Chile. The Meet was open to athletes who were born 1976 or later, with the international definition of a "junior" one with the international definition of a "junior" one who will not turn 20 during the year of competition (so for "Junior" age competition in 1995 one could not be bom in 1975, but anytime in 1976 as that athlete would not turn 20 during the year.

Melissa Price (PV), Angela Williams (100m), Julia Stamps (3000m), Joanna Hayes (100m Hurdles), and Suzy Powell (DT) were big local female stars in the meet, with Marques Hollwell (100m), Dea Marques (100m), Millia

Holiwell (100m), Obea Moore (400m), Mike Stember (1500m), and the rest of the UCLA weight crew Golden Staters starring on the male

Melissa Price, the Fresno-state bound recent grad of Kingsburg HS, was counting closely the big-meet chances she had left for a 13-foot pole vault clearance as she came into this meet, with a big 12-9 American Record the previous week end to win the Senior title in Sacramento. A field of 22 met the entry standard of 9 feet, with Californians dominating the event— Amanda Bauer was 5th (10-08), Glendale junior high star Bridget Pearson 4th (10-08), Kristi Draher 3rd (10-11.75), and surprising Vanessa Brenton 2nd (11-03.75), with our star Price coming in at 3.05 (10-03,75), with our star Price coming in at 3.05 (10-00) and then next trying the 3.45m (11-03.75) height, surprisingly taking two attempts to clear there. Brenton, 3722 points last year in the Hepitathlon, ended the weekend shockingly as the #5 U.S. Female Pole Vaulter ever (!) at 11-03,75, the #3 Junior-age Vaulter in U.S. History, and the #2 All-Time High Schooler in the event. Anyway, Price was over 3.55 (11-07.75) on her first attempt while the gallest Brenton went out. first attempt while the gallant Brenton went out there. Melissa next was over 3.70 (12-01.5) on her second attempt, with three attempts to get over 3.81 (12-06). With much of crowd remain-ing after the end of the running events to watch Price at the end of Saturday evening, the serious stuff started now, with a first attempt clearance

of 3.91 (12-10) and shocking first trial clearance of 4.01 (13-01.75). The crowd went nuts, with Price making three attempts at 4.06 (13-03.75), ending the evening as World History's =#7 Pole Vaulter ever, with a great close to her Golden State season. It was a neat close to a fine meet.

A star was born in the Women's 100 Meters. A great field was gathered which included NCAA 6th placer Kwajalein Butler (LSU), Andrea Anderson, Kelli White, Aminah Haddad, Jernae Wright, and Texas 5A Champ Kim McGruder—none of them would win! Frosh Angela Williams, State 400m (53.40) champ, dropped to the 100 here, with a blazing 11.30w (+2.2) first heat win over Jernae Wright (11.62w). Kelli White (11.43w +2.6), Kwajalein Butler (11.37w +2.9), and Andrea Anderson (11.48w +2.1) were other Prelim Heat winners, and one just had a sense when the serious run and the just had a series when the serious run-ning started the elders would take over. Ha! Ha! you think. In one of California prep history's amazing break-throughs, Angela Williams ab-solutely took apart this great group of young sprinters, out even with them, but after 15 meters shifting into a gear that none of these athletes was able to cope with this evening, blasting to a two meter win at 11.24 (wind +1.9) over Butler 11.43, with the other prep veterans back a meter from there. It was an unreal performance that left spectators speechless! It took down the that left spectators speechless! It took down the old national frosh record of Brenda Winston (San Gorgonio, San Bemardino) 11.60 from 1976, and amazingly makes Williams the #4 prep U.S. 100 meter runner in history behind Chandra Cheeseborough (11.13), Marion Jones (11.14), and Wendy Vereen (11.17). Marion's 11.17 at age 15 was the only record she did not get, but the 11.24 did take down Marion's 11.29 Junior Championship Meet Record from 1991. Interestingly, Marion made her big breakthrough and showed the same spark at age 15 in her sprint sweep of National Athlete of the 15 in her sprint sweep of National Athlete of the Year Zundra Feagin in the Arcadia/Foot Locker Invitational when she ran 11.38 and 22.87 (latter Williams did have absolutely perfect conditions with an eighty degree evening, 1.9 meters of second of wind behind her and all, but it was her margin of domination over the nation's best in this age-group that was overwhelming! The 4.23 GPA student from Chino HS played as a guard on the school's JV Basketball team this past winter, with many of her practice sessions spent in previous years on this facility as a member of the Southern California Cheetahs Track Club while growing up.

Over 200 meters (Angela Williams did not run the event here) Kelli White was the winner at 23.49 (+1.20), with Aminah Haddad 23.58 for second, and Andrea Anderson 4th at 23.82.


Julia Stamps put on another show, here in the 3000 meter event. With the eligible Stanford Collegiate crew (Sarna Renfro and Kortney Dunacombe) tired after a long year at that lev-el, Julia had to do the work here herself. A fairly sophisticated group of preps rolled through the first 400 at 77 seconds all right on Stamps' shoulder, at which point the Santa Rosa soph decided 77-80 second laps would not get the time she wanted this day. Moving it up to 73 for the second go-round, Julia quickly separated herself from the pack and seemed intent on 75 second laps, a pace that would come out to the low 9:20's, quicker than the 9:28.50 she ran in low 9:20's, quicker than the 9:28.50 she ran in this meet last year when she had company for all the pacing work. A 3:08 first 1000 meters was right at that 75 second per lap tempo, with the second 1000 meters, again totally solo, a bit quicker (3:05.4) 8:13.4. This is some serious running, right at 10:00 pace for a full 3200m, so the fatigue eventually did set in, with our star getting to the one lap to go point needing a final 400 under 73 seconds to get both the national age-16 and soph class record of 9:22.68 by Ai-leen O'Connor from Maryland way back in 1977. It was not easy, but the Foot Locker Na-tional Cross-Country champ came through with a determined effort over the entire final 400 me-ters, breaking through the finish line at 9:21.99, just off the Meet Record of 9:21.0 by Ceci Hopp, one of Julia's buddies, from way back in 1984. The age and grade record had fallen, with one of California's fabled running careers continuing to force the printers to lay down new lines of print in the record books. Joanna Hayes continued her spectacular

senior prep season of hurdling here. At this level we are wading into some real heavies, with et we are wading into some real neavies, with Latasha Colander, last year's Arcadia/Foot Locker winner in the 100m Hurdles going on to place second in the 1994 World Junior Championships at 13.30, with a 13.27 this spring and 6th in the NCAA Division I meet for the University of North Carolina. Yolanda McCray (University of Miami) was the other 1995 Co-World Junior leader with a 13.27 best from earlier this spring. Only two girls would make the LLS Pan spring. Only two girls would make the U.S. Pan American team, so Miss Hayes had her hands full! 13.55 performer Bisa Grant (UCLA) and Davetta Shepherd were other significant Golden Staters part of a great field. Colander (13.67 +1.60), Hayes (13.35w +3.30), and Grant (13.85w +2.20) were Prelim Heat winners, as it

took 14.00 (I) to make the Finals (Shepherd was 13.83w for third behind Hayes to qualify)! Joanna's Finals race was another this day for the highlights reel, running with the pack for two flights, then steadily pulling away to an unreal 13.06w (+2.50) win over Colander's 13.27w in second. The 13.06w makes Hayes the #2 All-Time U.S. Prep performer under any conditions (behind Candy Young's 12.95), and the #4 U.S. Junior ever. Joanna had as good a high school season as any prep in the nation in any event, with some great running ahead at UCLA over the next four years. Grant was 4th at 13.60w and Shepard 6th at 13.72w. Joanna came back for fifth in the 400m hurdles at 59.07, with Angela Harris, last year's prep state champ at Skyline of Oaldand, 6th at 59.67.

Suzy Powell continued her fine first season at UCLA, lengthening her best in the Discus ear-

lier this spring out to a U.S. Junior All-Time best of 190-06, and finishing off her local season in fine style here. A fine series had Suzy dominate the competition with 172-01, 176-05, 175-05, 181-01, 181-00, and 175-03 throws setting a new Meet Record in bettering her own 180-08 from two years ago in Spokane, Washington, Mandy Buckey threw a fine 154-07 for sixth place, with Nadia Lopez 8th at 152-05, and Chaniqua Ross 9th at 151-04.

The male side of the competition had its local stars! Preps Marques Holiwell, Obea Moore, and Michael Stember starred in fine comeption. Marques Holiwell, part of a top sprint group that included numerous NCAA Division! conference finalists at the top level, had the quickest Prelim time of 10.37 (wind +1.7). In the Finals, the University of Arizona-bound West Bakersfield HS star closed spectacularly, as always, over the final 40 meters, to win in a yearly national prep best of 10.33 (wind +1.70).

In the 400 meters, Obea Moore would renew a rivalry with Connecticut prep Jerome Young, who Moore had edged 45.88-45.89 in the Golden West Invitational the second weekend of the month. Obea (46.69) and Young (46.84) were heat winners, with two-time Arcadia/Foot Locker champ, Desmond Johnson (Louisiana prep) the other qualifying race winner at 46.69. At the Golden West, Obea had come from behind to take Young (and Johnson). This week Moore was out even, at 21.6 through 200m with Young. With 120 meters to go the shoe was on the other foot this time round, as Young sammed on the accelerator and powerfully edged away from Obea, recording a spectacular 45.01 clocking, with Moore second at 45.63. Obea's 45.63 is the #2 soph time ever behind William Reed's 45.4 tenth grade record, with Young's 45.01 winner the #2 prep clocking ever in the event, behind Darrell Robinson's 44.69 National Record from 1982. Only Henry Thomas (45.09), Calvin Harrison (45.25), and Bill Green (45.51) sit shead of Moore among California preps on the all-time list.

California Prep stars, Michael Stember and Brandon Pacheco, were Friday Prelim Heat 1500m winners at 3:54.35 and 3:53.48, respectively. The duo have faced each a number of times, with Saturday's Finals controlled by the twosome. USC-bound Pacheco was out at 61.0 (400m), with the Brethren Christian star, who came quite a ways from 4:27.01 (1994) to 4:08.50 in the last year over 1600m, still ahead at 2:05.5 for 800m. As he has done recently, Stember picks a lap and a half to go ahead, with his move here against a more mature field seemingly more controlled than some others, but once the Jesuit HS star took the lead one had the sense that the race was under his control, with a 59.2 final 400 bringing Michael home at 3:49.74, with Pacheco a pleasant surprise in second at 3:50.26.

The UCLA weight crew usually has this as a "clinic" to show the ability of Coach Art Venegas to successfully work with some of the nation's most talented young athletes. Suzy Powell had starred on the Women's side, with Luke Sullivan (179-10) and Scott McPherran (179-05) taking 1-2 in the Discus here. Matt Pentecost, not yet a Bruin as a recent graduate of Loyola HS in L.A., surprised with a win in the Shot Put, tossing the 16 pound implement out to 54-06.

Carla Estes looked very strong in taking the 400m event at 53.27, with second place a bit of a surprise. Frosh Kadrina Coffee had had a fine season at Palmdale HS after a fabled age-group career, with a big finish here and improvement

by over a second to 53.96 to earn her U.S. National uniform for the Pan Am team! State HS Champ in the High Jump, Tara Flaming, faced fellow 6-footer Jeana McDowell of Arizona, with McDowell winning at 5-11.25, but Flaming having few misses on the way to her 5-10 best to place second and make the U.S. team.

Mt. SAC's own Jason McGinnis led a California 1-2-3 sweep in the Men's High Jump,

SAC's own Jason McGinnis led a California 1-2-3 sweep in the Men's High Jump. with Jeremy Fisher, finishing his first year at the Big-10 Champion school, University of Wisconsin, second and State prep champ, Michael Wilkins, third, all at the same 7-00.25 height. Borya Orloff of UC Irvine by way of St. John Bosco HS in Bellflower, was the Pole Vault winner at a fine 17-00. Clarence Scott continued his fine year in the Long Jump, running into 25-10.5 jumper Dominick Milner of the University of Florida, with Milner 25-03.25w (+6.50) to win, with Scott earning his U.S. jersey with a 24-08.25w (+7.60) for second. Marc Mazzoni took the Hammer over a College group at 178-06. Justin Marrujo took the 10k walk at 46:16.1, an improvement over his 1994 winning 46:50.31 time.

Rondie Gibbs, from Cal Poly, Pomona forced the pace for most of the Men's 10,000m event, eventually finishing second to the University of Portland's Tim Briggs 30:57.95-31:12.53. Konrad Knutsen, at the University of Oregon via Del Campo HS in Fair Oaks, was second in the Steeplechase at 9:23.7, with prep Jeremy Lyon of Hesperia running an excellent 9:30.2 prep time in third.

Felix Sanchez ran a super 400m Hurdles race, finishing third in 51.33, the #14 Prep per-

formance ever in U.S. History.

A fine Women's Heptathlon competition had Orange County prep stars Kerry O'Bric and Ashley Bethel battling for high placings. Bethel sat in second after the first day, with O'Bric in fifth. Kerry suprisingly won the Long Jump portion of the event at 18-04.75 (Bethel 17-01.75) with Ashley 3rd (3646) at that point and O'Bric 4th (3597) overall. O'Bric was 110-00 for fourth in the Javelin to move into third at 4141, with Bethel 91-06 (8th) and 4083 for fourth going into the final 800m event. Kerry was 2:33.49 in that two lap run, with Ashley 2:38.85. O'Bric finished third at 4791, up from her tenth here a year ago, with Bethel in 6th at 4669, but impressively establishing new National Age-15 and Frosh class records (old age 4640 by Tiffany Lott of Utah from 1991 and grade 4540 Brandy Venable from Mississippi from 1985). The two athletes who finished ahead of O'Bric (who has 1978 year of birth) in the competition both have 1976 years of birth, so they are ineligible for the 1996 Junior Meet (those born 1977 and later eligible for that 1996 competition), which will qualify on to the World Junior Championships in Australia next summer. Bethel, with her 1980 year of birth was by over a year the youngest athlete in the field of sixteen! Danny Haag, 1994 grad of Granada Hills HS, was a strong third in the Men's Decathlon with 7148 points.

her local prep career with a third place in the 800m at 2:08.64, a race taken out at 58.8 for the first 400m by New Yorker Tameika Grizzle and won by New Jerseyite Hazel Clark, at 2:06.18. A very good Women's Triple Jump event, by far the strongest field ever gathered for this meet, had six athletes jump beyond 41 feet, with Arcadia/Foot Locker Athlete of the Meet LaShonda Christopher of Washington the winner at 43-01, and Amy Littlepage 4th at 41-08w (+2.30). There were a ton of other Californians who were very competitive and are listed in the results that follow.


