

THREE STATE RECORDS FALL IN KANSAS MEET

Cross Stretches Broad Jump Distance 1-4 Inch.

Normal Team Wins Meet, Baker Places Second and Fairmount Finishes in Third Place.

Emporia, Kan., May 19.—Three state records were broken in the eleventh annual inter-collegiate state track and field meet won by the Kansas Normal here this afternoon, with a total score of 52 points. Baker university won second, with 25 1-7 points, and Fairmount, of Wichita, third, with 23 points. The other nine colleges in the meet finished as follows:

Southwestern, 19 1-4; Friends, 16 1-7; Ottawa, 10 1-7; Bethany, 3; College of Emporia, 3; Pittsburg Normal, 2 1-2; Hays Normal, 1 1-2; Cooper, 1; Washburn, 2-7.

Cross, Normal, who won two firsts and who also helped win the relay, broke the state record by one-fourth inch in the broad jump, leaping 22 feet 1 1-4 inches. Cassidy, who won all Ottawa's points, raised the record on pole vault to 11 feet 3 1-4 inches. Stiles, Normal, threw the javelin 170 feet, adding 12 feet 6 1-2 inches to the old record.

Taylor, of Baker, who won the shot put, attempted to break the state record with three extra trials, but fell short one-half inch.
