

Ottawa, Kan., May 4.—The 1918 track and field championship of the Kansas Intercollegiate Athletic association was won by the Southwestern team with a lead of 43 points, Baker of Baldwin, second, 36.5; Friends, Wichita, 29.75; Pittsburg Normal, 17.
