

# **BAKER UNIVERSITY WINS KANSAS CONFERENCE MEET ON A SLIPPERY TRACK**

Pittsburg, May 16.—Baker university won the Kansas conference track and field meet held here today, piling up a total of 38½ points. Ottawa university was second with 31½ points. Fairmount followed with 19; Emporia Normal, 15; Friends university, 14; College of Emporia, 14; Southwestern college, 13; Pittsburg Normal, 11½; Bethany college, 5½, and Washburn university, 3.

Kastor, of Southwestern, was high man with 13 individual points. Cochran, of Ottawa, was second with 12½, and Nye, of Baker, third, with 9¼ points. Boger, of Fairmount, Vaughn, of the Emporia Normal, and Rodgers, of Ottawa, each made 8 points.

J. C. Grover, of the Kansas City Athletic club, was referee and starter.

For the first time in recent years, no records were broken at the annual meet. This was probably due to the fact that recent rains made the track heavy and the field slippery.

The conference tennis tournament, both singles and doubles for men and women, opens tomorrow. Seven colleges and normals have entered contestants.
