

# Ottawa Second in Annual Kansas Conference Track Meet Held at Salina

SALINA, KAN., May 17.—(A)—In a rain storm, Baker university scored 68 points to win the 1935 Kansas college athletic conference track and field meet here today. Ottawa was second with 50 points.

Ed Dissinger, Baker, winner of the mile and two-mile runs, was the individual star with 13 points. No conference records were endangered.

The business meeting of the conference was postponed until later and tennis was deferred until next week when eastern schools will play at Ottawa and western schools either at Bethany or McPherson.
