

BAKER IS FOURTH

Ottawa University Track Team Runs Away With Kansas Conference Meet

Baldwin, Kan., May 14. (AP)—Ottawa university ran away with the Kansas conference track title yesterday, scoring in 13 of the 15 events for a point total of 65, well ahead of College of Emporia which finished second with 38.

Other scores: McPherson 29, Baker 22½, Kansas Wesleyan 10½ and Bethany none.

To win Ottawa took six firsts, seven seconds and six thirds. High scorers for Ottawa were Mattis in the hurdles, O'Neil in the dashes and Meek in the shot and discus. Smith of Baker won the 440-yard dash for the third time in four years.

The conference golf title also went to Ottawa, when sharpshooting George van Arb finished the tourney with 234, which was 26 strikes better than second place, which went to E. Woods, also of Ottawa.

Lysell and Monson of Bethany captured the conference tennis doubles title, defeating Barngrove and Rothrock of McPherson 6-3, 3-6, 8-6.

Kansas conference coaches elected Lester Sells, College of Emporia, president, and Richard Godlove, Ottawa, secretary-treasurer.
