

# C. of E. Fourth in Conference Meet

Baldwin, May 17 (AP)—Baker university performed as expected and successfully defended its title in the annual Kansas conference track and field meet here Friday.

Baker won eight firsts and tied for two others in rolling up a total of 58 2-3 points. Kansas Wesleyan was second with 31 1-3, Ottawa had 21, College of Emporia 20, Bethany 14, McPherson 10 1-3 and Bethel 9 2-3.

Individual scoring honors went to Findley, Baker, who was first in the 100 and 220-yard dashes and was a member of the winning mile relay team. He had 11 1-4 points. Tilberg of Bethany was right behind with 11.

Firsts for C. of E. were scored by Loren Neill, in the 440-yard dash, and by Ernest Wertzberger in the shot put. Dale Washburn tied with Hodges of Baker for first place in the pole vault. Other Emporia point makers were Warren Taylor, third in the high hurdles; Neill, second in the 220, and Bob Foncannon, fourth in the 2-mile.
