OTTAWA WINS KANSAS CONFERENCE TRACK MEET

The Ottawa Braves successfully defended the Kansas Conference track crown Friday of last week, as they came in first in seven of the events and scored in all events but the dashes to amass 68½ and take the meet for the second straight year.

The Coyotes nosed out the Baked Wildcats for second place, scoring 26 points to the Cats 25. Bethel collected 20½ for fourth place, C of E took fifth with 18, McPherson sixth with 7 and Bethany was last, failing to garner a point.

The Coyotes were first in two of the field events. Ervin Kimble tossed the Discus 122'3%" to win the Discus. Floyd Yaussi took fourth in that event. Quint Manely took first in the Shot Put, hurling the shot 40' 10½". Quint also finished second in the 100 yd. dash, and third in the 220.

In the century run Truman Haskell, 32 year old C of E sprinter, set a new conference record striding the distance in 9.9 seconds. Manely was second and White third in this event.

In the hotly contested mile relay Ed Doherty, of the Coyotes, passed Elmer Harbour of Ottawa in the back stretch of the last lap, but Harbour in a burst of speed sprinted home to win, and Ed brought the baton home second for Wesleyan.
