

OTTAWA -- Ottawa university won its eighth straight Kansas conference track title Friday, as expected.

The Braves piled up 86 5/7 points easily to outdistance second-place McPherson, with 70 6/7.

The expected battle between McPherson and Baker for second did not take place. The Bulldogs waltzed home in the runner-up spot while Baker finished a poor third with 47 4/7 points.

Kansas Wesleyan a pre-meet pick for fourth, finished as predicted. The Coyotes, however, scored only 12 points, not quite as many as had been anticipated.

Bethel was fifth with 3 6/7. Bethany and College of Emporia shared the sixth spot with 3 points each.

Three new records were established in the meet. In the broad jump, Paul Wheaton of Ottawa leaped 23 feet, beating the old mark of 22 feet, 10 inches, set by Starr of Ottawa in 1936.

In the high jump, Ken Sterns of Baker leaped 6 feet, 3 3/4, to best the old mark, set by himself, by one-half inch. Sterns jumped 6 feet, 3 1/4 inches in 1949.

In the shot put, Dick Meiers of Ottawa got off a heave of 45 feet, one-half inch, besting by a half-inch the old record. Lange, Baker, tossed 45 feet in 1939.

Wheaton of Ottawa and Dale Carpenter of McPherson staged a personal scoring duel with Wheaton coming out on top, 18 1/4 to 18.

Keith Mueller placed second in two events, the mile run and 880, for Wesleyan's best showing.
