

Held to only one first-place finish, the College of Emporia Presbics dropped to fourth in the Kansas Conference track meet at Salina Friday afternoon. Ottawa University won the league crown with 65 points while Bethel was runnerup with 42 points.

In the battle for third, fourth and fifth places, McPherson collected 27 1-3 points, the Presbics had 26½, and Kansas Wesleyan had 23½ points. Rounding out the scoring were Bethany with 14 points, Friends with 13½, and Baker with 13.

Tommy Coleman defending league dash champion, collected the only blue ribbon for C. of E. winning the 220-yard dash in 23.7 seconds. The speedy Presby Dash was upset in the 100-yard dash by Ottawa's Bob Knight, who finished first in 10.2 seconds.

Ottawa scored in all but three events, in piling up its point total. The Braves were shut out in only the high jump, the 120-yard high hurdles and the two-mile run.

Knight was the meet's top individual performer. In addition to edging Coleman for top honors in the 100, he also won the broad jump with a leap of 21 feet 5¼ inches, and placed second in the 880-yard run.

Ottawa piled up most of its points on second, third, fourth and fifth places finishes as they collected only three first places. Kansas Wesleyan, McPherson and Bethel each picked up three blue ribbons, while C. of E., Baker and Bethel had one each.

In addition to Coleman's second place finish in the 100, Clarence Howland was runnerup for C. of E. in the 220-yard low hurdles. Other Presby places were garnered by Kenney Miller who tied for third in the high jump and placed fifth in the javelin; Howland, who was third in the high hurdles; Richard Garrelts, who was fifth in the mile run; Jerry Baker, who tied for fourth in the pole vault; and the mile relay team, which finished third behind Kansas Wesleyan and Ottawa.
