

Southwestern Retains Its KCAC Track Crown

Saturday, May 19—

WINFIELD, Kan. (AP)—Southwestern rolled up 149½ points Friday in retaining its Kansas Conference track championship.

College of Emporia and Baker tied at 84. Ottawa had 34 1-3, Bethel 26, Kansas Wesleyan 22½, Friends 21, Sterling 20 1-3, McPherson 19 1-3, and Bethany 4 1-3.

Top individual was Jim Peppers of Southwestern with 24 points, collected by winning the 440, placing second in the 220 and third in the low hurdles.

A javelin record of 224 feet 10 inches was set by A. G. Boley

of Southwestern, who posted the former mark of 105 feet last year.
