

Ottawa Captures KCAC Track Title

OTTAWA — Ottawa scored 88 points and captured the Kansas Conference track and field title here Saturday.

There were new records set in the broad jump, 2-mile run and pole vault, as well as records established in the 800-yard relay, intermediate hurdles and triple jump, new events in the conference this season.

Baker's Wildcats came in second with 76½ points, Kansas Wesleyan was third with 75 points, Friends scored 66, Southwestern and Sterling 51 each, McPherson 46½, College of Emporia 34, Bethel 30 and Bethany 12.

Claude Johnson of Baker scored 23 feet, 7¼ inches to win the

broad jump and break the meet record of 23-5¼ set by Southwestern's Jim Boley in 1962.

Harold Rush of Friends took the triple-jump, a new event, with a leap of 44-0¼.

Those two marks were established Friday.

Saturday the Ottawa 800-yard relay team was clocked at 1:30.1 to establish a record in this new event.

Dave Hartman of Sterling ran the 2-mile in 10:00.8 to top the old mark of 10:03.6 set by Brown of Ottawa in 1961.

In this same event Dennis Lambert set a new Kansas Wesleyan school record of 10:10.4. The old record was 10:18.9, also set by Lambert

earlier this year.

Charles Bowling of Ottawa soared 14 feet, 4¼ inches in the pole vault for a new loop mark. The old record was 13 feet, ¼ inch set by Huffman of McPherson in 1959.

Steve Scofield of Wesleyan ran the 800 in 1:38.2 for a new school record, breaking the old mark of 1:58.5 set by Vern Holsington in 1958.

Paul Peters also set a new school record for Wesleyan in the 330 yard intermediate hurdles. He finished third in 40.8, which broke his own record of 41.5 set earlier this year.

Rush, who had set triple jump

mark Friday, came back Saturday to win the intermediate hurdles in 38.9, which also will go into the books as a new record for this first-year event. Tom Holsington took Wesleyan's only first place award Saturday. He won the 220 in 22 seconds flat.
