

MCPHERSON, Kan. (AP) — Southwestern of Winfield won the Kansas Conference track meet Saturday with 115 points to 106 to runner-up Kansas Wesleyan. Host McPherson was third with 105.

Five conference records were broken.

Ottawa placed fourth with 97 points, followed by Bethel 42, Baker 23½, Friends and Sterling 20 apiece, Tabor 17½, Bethany 9, and College of Emporia 8.

The records were in the pole vault, mile relay, 3,000 meter steeplechase, 880 run and 440 intermediate hurdles.

Glenn Appell

Glenn Appell of Kansas Wesleyan who set the record of 1:53. in the 880, also won the mile in 4:18.3 and placed second in the steeplechase in which teammate Rich Akusu broke Appell's 1968 record of :9.47. Akusu's time was 9:28.8. The old record in the 880 was 1:54.3 by McClanahan, College of Emporia.

Mike Butsch of McPherson set a pole vault record of 14 feet, 4¾ inches. The old mark was set in 1964 by Bowling of Ottawa at 14-4½.

The Ottawa relay team set a record in the mile relay of 3:18.8. The old record was 3:21.6 by Southwestern in 1967.

Ken Fast, Tabor, set a record in the 440 intermediate hurdles of :53.8. The old mark was :55.7 by Gene Meeks of Ottawa in 1967.

In addition to his first in the 880, first in the mile and second

in the 3-mile, Appell took second in the steeplechase and was the meet's high point man with 36 points.

Akusu was second in individual points with 34. Besides his first in the steeplechase and 3-

mile, he was second in the mile and third in the 850.
