- John` Muthama LINDSBORG of Bethel ran to 4 new Kansas con-ference records, and Bethany destroyed its opposition in the team race at the KCAC track and field championships held here Friday night. McPherson won the women's

Muthama was named the outstanding male athlete in the meet as the foreign distance ace broke marks in the 880-yard run, mile run, steeplechase, and 3-mile. Bethany's men ran up a total of 217 points in the meet, 105 more than 2nd place McPherson's total of 112. The McPherson women scored 138 points to finish 29 points ahead of Bethel's 109.

It was Bethany's first Kansas conference track championship in the 68 year history of the event.

Muthama's individual performance was by far the best of the meet considering he ran the mile, 880, and 3000-meter steeplechase, all within 2 hours. In the process he smashed 4 Kansas Wesleyan conference records. Richard Akusu held the 3-mile and steeplechase marks, and Glenn Appell held the 880 and mile records.

While Muthama was putting on his awesome display, Bethany was running away with the team title, and in the process set one new conference record, and 8 school marks. Leland Nelson of the Swedes threw the shot 54-91/2 to break the old mark of 53-7 by Roger Kamla of McPherson in 1973.

Kresge sets record The only other conference record set

was by Kansas Wesleyan's Jim Kresge in the 440-yard intermediates. The Coyote hurdles ace was timed in :53.75, breaking the mark of :53.8 by Dennis Fast of Tabor in 1969.

Willie Reed was a double winner for the Swedes, winning the 100 and 220 yard dashes in : :09.85 and :21.83 respectively.

This was the first year for women's track and field in the conference. Three athletes were double winners; Stephens of McPherson, winning the javelin and discus; Habegger of Beth-el, winning the 100 and 220-yard dashes; and Alexander of Bethel, taking the 880 and mile run.
