

Dallas Long Breaks Shot Record---63-7

Dallas Long got off a shot put during yesterday's SPAAU Relays that he said "felt funny" and which his SC coach, Jess Mortensen, described as "not good technically."

But the 16-lb. ball sailed 63 ft. 7 in., and that's 5 in. better than Parry O'Brien's world record.

The huge Trojan sophomore also had a 63-7 effort last spring, but it was disallowed. Chances are that yesterday's performance eventually will be recognized by the International Amateur Athletic Federation. Meet officials said everything appeared to be in order, so if the field surveys level and the shot again weighs out okay tomorrow, the mark will be submitted for acceptance as a new world standard.

Long began rather unimpressively, at least for him, yesterday. He did 60-6½, then 59-11½, then fouled, and was trailing Dave Davis of the Striders.

 get six trials, but because of the big entry list they got only four yesterday. Dallas, unaware that his final putt was coming up, made what he termed a "relaxed" toss, supposedly saving the big one for last.

"When Dallas can do 63-7 on a herky-jerky put like that, 65 ft. isn't far away for him," Mortensen predicted.

Athlete Surprised
 "I sure was surprised," the 260-lb. athlete commented. "My plan this year was to start slowly and build up instead of flattening out like I did in 1959. But I'm still going to take it easy until later in the season. How that one went so far I'll never know."

The 63ft. 7in. Dallas achieved last year in an SC-UCLA freshman meet was "illegal" because it came on a seventh attempt. That same day, he also bettered the world record with 63ft. 2 1/2 in., but that one also failed to qualify for consideration because the teobard wasn't high enough.

Meet records fell right and left as more than 900 collegians and clubmen competed at ELAJC Stadium.

Sun Devils Sizzle
 Among the new marks was a discus throw of 182ft. 5 1/2 in. by 37-year-old Fortune Gordien, the recognized world champion who is attempting a comeback in hopes of making the United

States Olympic team for the fourth time.

The Arizona State quartet of Mike Barrick, Karl Schreiner, Mel Spence and Mal Spence shattered a 20-year mile relay record by speeding the distance in 3:11.6, which is terrific time, especially for March yet.

SC's foursome of Rusty Weeks, Bruce Munn, Bobby Staten and Jim Bates set records of 41.6 in the 440 relay and 1:25.4 in the 880, while the Striders' combine of Bob Shankland, Chuck Kirkby, Jerome Walters and Marshall Clark topped the two-mile mark with a 7:36 performance. —Al Wolf
