

28 Records Fall in AAU Spikefest

Saturday's frigid weather failed to chill the wholesale record breaking that occurs every year in the mammoth SPAAU Relays.

Twenty-eight new marks were set in the day-long competition at East Los Angeles JC—and one of those performances bettered a national standard.

Fullerton's fleet foursome of C h u c k Baer, Mike Howard, Harry McCalla and Jan Underwood ran the two-mile relay in 7:47.7 for a national junior college record. The previous best clocking of 7:48.1 was achieved by Compton in 1956.

The fractions were 1:58.5 for Baer, 1:59.7 for Howard, 1:54.3 for McCalla and 1:54.9 for Underwood.

SC Sets Mark

Six records were erased in the university-open class.

SC's 440 relay team of Rusty Weeks, Jim Bates, Bob Pierce and Bruce Munn did 41.5. Rex Cawley replaced Pierce in the 880 relay and another record of 1:25.2 materialized.

Occidental came through with a two-mile baton mark of 7:55.8 and Arizona State lowered the mile relay best to 3:10.4.

Don Dornan, Mike Farmer, Dave Moon and Jim Cerveny comprised the Oxy quartet, while Mike Barrick, Karl Schreiner, Mel Spence and Mal Spence did the honors for Arizona State.

Hurdles Record Falls

In the high hurdles, the record of 14.3 was topped twice. The Trojans' Pierce won his heat in 14.1, while C. K. Yang of UCLA achieved that same time in the finals as Pierce slowed to 14.5 and second place.

As usual, the pole vault was the last event to end, but it produced a record, too, when Bob Rose of Arizona State cleared 14ft. 10in.

Though SC finished only third in the mile relay, Cawley ripped off a sensational 46.4 leg.

Bob Humphreys of the Striders captured the discus with a fling of 183-1 after doing 56-9 in the shot.

Long Easy Winner

Dallas Long of SC, as anticipated, won the shot with a modest, for him, heave of 60-1/2. Dave Davis of San Fernando State, making his first competitive appearance of 1961, did 58-2.

Two good javelin performances were registered. Jan Sikorsky of the Camp Pendleton Marines sent the spear 230-5 and Chuck Wilkinson of Redlands 237-5.

Sixty started in the 5,000-meter run, but at the finish line it was Ron Larriev of

Cal Poly (Pomona) all by his lonesome as he covered the distance in 14:32.8.
