

20 MEET RECORDS TUMBLE IN LONG BEACH RELAYS

Athletes outnumbered fans at the annual Long Beach Relays in Veterans Memorial Stadium Saturday, but the 1,274 cash customers got their money's worth (and maybe a few head colds in the bargain) as 20 meet records tumbled.

Outstanding baton event was the 2-miler, won by the UCLA combine of Dennis Breckow, Kurt Klein, Arnd Kruger and Bob Day in 7:26.4.

USC's Dave Buck, Bruce Bess, Charles Oakley and Dennis Carr finished second in 7:28.4.

Marks Shattered

Both teams thus shattered the meet mark of 7:29.2 set by Occidental in 1963. Further, the Bruins' clocking was the fastest winning performance in school history.

Gary Carlsen of USC established a new discus standard of 171 feet 11 inches, while Ed Caruthers of Santa Ana College equalled the high-jump record of 6-10. John Rambo of Cal State Long Beach likewise achieved that height, but had to settle for second place because of more misses.

The best trick of the day was turned by Don Shy of Mt. San Antonio College, who skimmed the 120-yard high hurdles course in 14.3—against a stiff breeze.

Sam Workman of Fresno State scored a double, taking the 100 in 9.6 and long-jumping 24-11.

McCullough Nipped

Workman came from behind to nip Earl McCullough of Long Beach City College and Phil Lee of USC, who were timed in 9.7. The sprinters had the wind at their backs.

Workman's fleet teammate, Darel Newman, wasn't among those present. He stayed home to wrestle with a strep throat.

Auguring well for the Trojan football team next fall, gridgers Rod Sherman, Mike Hull and Phil Lee teamed with Steve Firenze to capture the 440 relay in 42 flat.
