

Trojans' Hines Leaps at Chance to Upstage McAlister---Goes 26-0

Henry Hines just wanted to let everybody know that there's another long jumper in town.

James McAlister has been getting most of the attention with his early season heroics at UCLA, but Hines went a few inches better Saturday, equaling the USC record of 26 feet in the Long Beach Relays at Long Beach Veterans Stadium.

There was no wind on the jump which tied Wellesley Clayton's school standard, set in 1965, and missed Ralph Boston's meet record by only a quarter of an inch.

Hines, a 21-year-old transfer from Sacramento City College who sat out last year, also ran legs on winning Trojan teams in the 880 and mile relays.

Little Competition

The Trojans, with little competition from club teams which entered makeshift teams, won every relay they entered and also won four field events. Lance Babb, a transfer from L.A. City College, won the high hurdles in 14.0 against a slight breeze.

Willie Deckard, another LACC transfer, anchored wins in the 440 relay (41.0) and 880 relay (1:24.9), clocking a 19.5 furlong in the latter event.

Edesel Garrison had a 47.4 lap in the mile relay and Nathan Burks, a freshman from Castlemont High, turned in a 1:53.0 leg in the two mile relay.

Hines, 6-0 and 165, set a National JC record of 26-5

at Sacramento, then slipped to 26-2 3/4 last year when he was troubled by injuries.

How does he feel about McAlister who already has done 25-9 1/4?

"I'm kind of skeptical," he said, "of guys who get their best marks in early meets. Jumpers like Jerry Proctor and myself like to start slow and peak for the big meets in May and June."

Hines, who doesn't lack for confidence, didn't appear too impressed by 26 feet.

"I'm pleased," he said, "but I'm not satisfied. I won't be satisfied until I do 28 feet. That's my target for the Olympic year."

As for McAlister, he seemed reluctant to talk about the Bruin freshman, but as a parting shot to newsmen, he said, "You be there, May 8."

That's the date of the USC-UCLA meet.
